All Soldiers including fully vaccinated Soldiers, arriving from or through a CDC THN level 2, 3, or 4 country to Alaska will take a COVID-19 test (1) during the 3 days prior to departure of the commercial or military flight from the foreign country and (2) 3 to 5 days completion of travel, you will report with the necessary orders and paperwork to begin the in-processing procedures with Reception in building 602.
