



- All other services are fully opened or open with limited face-to-face appointments (with a combination of virtual health appointments)


Entrance Requirements:

Direct Contact is:

- Within six feet of a known COVID-19 positive person
- Contact is for 15 consecutive minutes

Direct Contact is NOT:

- Passing someone in the hallway or grocery store






