What is TRICARE® Online (TOL) Patient Portal Secure Messaging?

Who can access TOL Patient Portal Secure Messaging?

TOL Patient Portal Secure Messaging is accessible by Military Health System patients who receive care at a military hospital or clinic.

What are the Key Capabilities of TOL Patient Portal Secure Messaging?

How do I access TOL Patient Portal Secure Messaging?



1. Go to www.TRICAREOnline.com and click "Log In."
2. Log in with your DS Logon Premium (Level 2), DoD CAC or DFAS myPay credentials. If you do not have DS Logon credentials and would like to, click "Need An Account."
3. Click on the "Secure Messaging" icon.
4. Link your accounts by entering your Secure Messaging username and password and clicking **LINK**. **Before** linking accounts, be sure your Secure Messaging demographic information matches your DS Logon account information. You will then be taken to your Secure Messaging Home Page. When you select Secure Messaging from TOL PP in the future, you'll go directly to Secure Messaging without having to sign-in again.







DPW Project Update

River Road Bridge

✓ **Scope:**

- River Road Bridge has undergone a series of safety inspections. These inspections have determined that the bridge is safe. The inspections have identified the need for structural improvements.
- The River Road Bridge construction project was funded for repairs in the Spring/Summer of 2020. By the addressing the repairs now, it will be more cost effective and require less time to repair.

✓ **Schedule:**

- Estimated Reopening: ~August 2020
- Complete: ~October 2020





DPW Project Update

Bailey Bridge Project

✓ **Scope:**

- Bailey Road Bridge has undergone a series of safety inspections. These inspections had determined that the bridge was not safe.
- Original bridge was constructed in 1949, the bridge no longer met the mission needs. The Bailey Road Bridge was closed in September 2019. The Bailey Road Bridge construction project was funded for repairs in the Spring/Summer of 2020

✓ **Schedule:**

- Started: ~ April 2020
- Estimated Completion: ~ August 2020





DPW Project Update

Traffic Calming

✓ Scope:

- Install traffic control measures to improve the safe use of Gaffney Road, Neely Road, and 6th Street for vehicles and pedestrian traffic.
- Work will consist largely of the installation of speed humps and additional and improved signage, as well as improved paint lines.

✓ Schedule:

- Phase I: Complete
- Phase II: ~8-12 June

Unidirectional Water System Flushing (UDF)

Overview

- ✓ The fire hydrants on Post will be opened and flushed to scour the pipes and refresh the water distribution systems to ensure quality drinking water for our customers
- ✓ Flushing daily between 10:00am to 2:00pm Mon – Fri
- ✓ Customers may notice some intermittent discoloration in the water
 - Not harmful and should clear up quickly
 - Open your faucets and flush the water until the water is clear
 - contact your building maintenance provider, if the water remains discolored
- ✓ The POC for questions or problems with the water service that doesn't clear up may be forwarded to 455-1533





- ✓ With over 33,000 miles of shoreline, more than 3,000 rivers, and over 3 million lakes, Alaska is a boater's paradise.
- ✓ Unfortunately, Alaska has one of the highest boating fatality rates in the nation.





Cold Water

- ✓ Cold water shock
- ✓ Immersion hypothermia
- ✓ Impaired function
- ✓ Silt in many rivers



- ✓ **Check conditions early and often.- Rivers rise, lakes can be choppy- water is VERY COLD.**
- ✓ **Average temp is 45-55 degrees.**
