



Environmental Laws and Regulations

General:

The USAG Ansbach Environmental Management Division manages the environmental program focusing on a proactive approach through our [Environmental Management System \(EMS\)](#). The EMS is the overall umbrella under which the individual environmental topics are covered. These are mainly guided by the Environmental Final Governing Standards (FGS) for Germany. The FGS are a comprehensive set of country-specific substantive environmental provisions, typically technical limitations on effluent, discharges, etc., or a specific management practice. They try to integrate Host Nation laws into Army guidance :
