All-Season tires are a compromise.....but acceptable.

- Can be fined for not having appropriate tires for the weather conditions.
 - Manufacture sets standard on M & S tires.
 - If in doubt, keep tire description in you glove box.



Winter Drivers Training: Vehicle

Use Winter tires during months Winter

- ✓ Winter tires are mandatory in Germany whenever ice and snow are present.
- ✓ Be aware that all-season tires are a compromise and will not perform as well as snow tires.
- ✓ Effective 1 OCT 24, winter tires must have the alpine symbol.
- ✓ Must have tires installed BEFORE driving on snow and ice. Generally, from October to April (O bis O).
- ✓ To maximize safety and control, use the best snow tires available.
- ✓ Snow tires must be installed on all four wheels.

LEAD IN WATER SAMPLING



LEAD SAFETY

- IMCOM Policy requires sampling at government-owned Army Family Housing (AFH) and high-risk facilities (HRF) every 5 years.
- HRF's are those buildings with children age six and under and include Army family housing areas, child development centers, schools and youth centers.
- IMCOM SOP: Sample 20% of facilities per year so as to sample all government-owned AFH and HRF every 5 years.

100% HOUSING INSPECTION (JAN 2026)



100% Inspection Life Health Safety

- Congress mandated inspections of 100% of all Family housing on Army installations by an independent, third-party contractor.
- Intent is to ensure the Army's housing assets are safe and habitable.
- Inspections include all occupied and unoccupied homes and are conducted in accordance with the InterNACHI Standards of Practice.
- Home inspections are scheduled at USAG Ansbach January 2026.

BULK TRASH PICK-UP



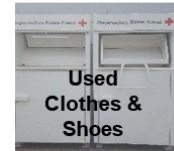
BULK TRASH

- On-post bulk trash pick-up has been reduced from monthly to semi-annually pick-up.
- New bulk trash pick-up times will coincide with Spring & Fall Clean Up.
- Bulk trash can still be taken to the Recycling Centers located at Katterback Kaserne, Bldg. 9024, and Storck Barracks, Bldg. 6689.
- Fall Clean-Up is scheduled from November 3-7, 2025.
- The last monthly bulk trash pick-up will occur October 1 and November 5, 2025.
- The next bulk trash pick-up will be in May 2026 during the Spring Clean-Up.

Prevention Plan

Bats aren't dangerous animals; however, in rare cases they might carry diseases, such as rabies. Sometimes bats can get lost and end up in office and residential buildings:

✓ **Reasons for increased risk of bat intrusions**

Females and young animals leave breeding colonies **about mid July** to approximately **mid-October**.

Heightened **hunting activity** to store fat before hibernating in the winter colonies.

✓ **Recommended measures**

Keep **windows closed** at night or install fly nets.

Refrain from making physical contact with bats.

Contact EMD in case of an active bat intrusion.

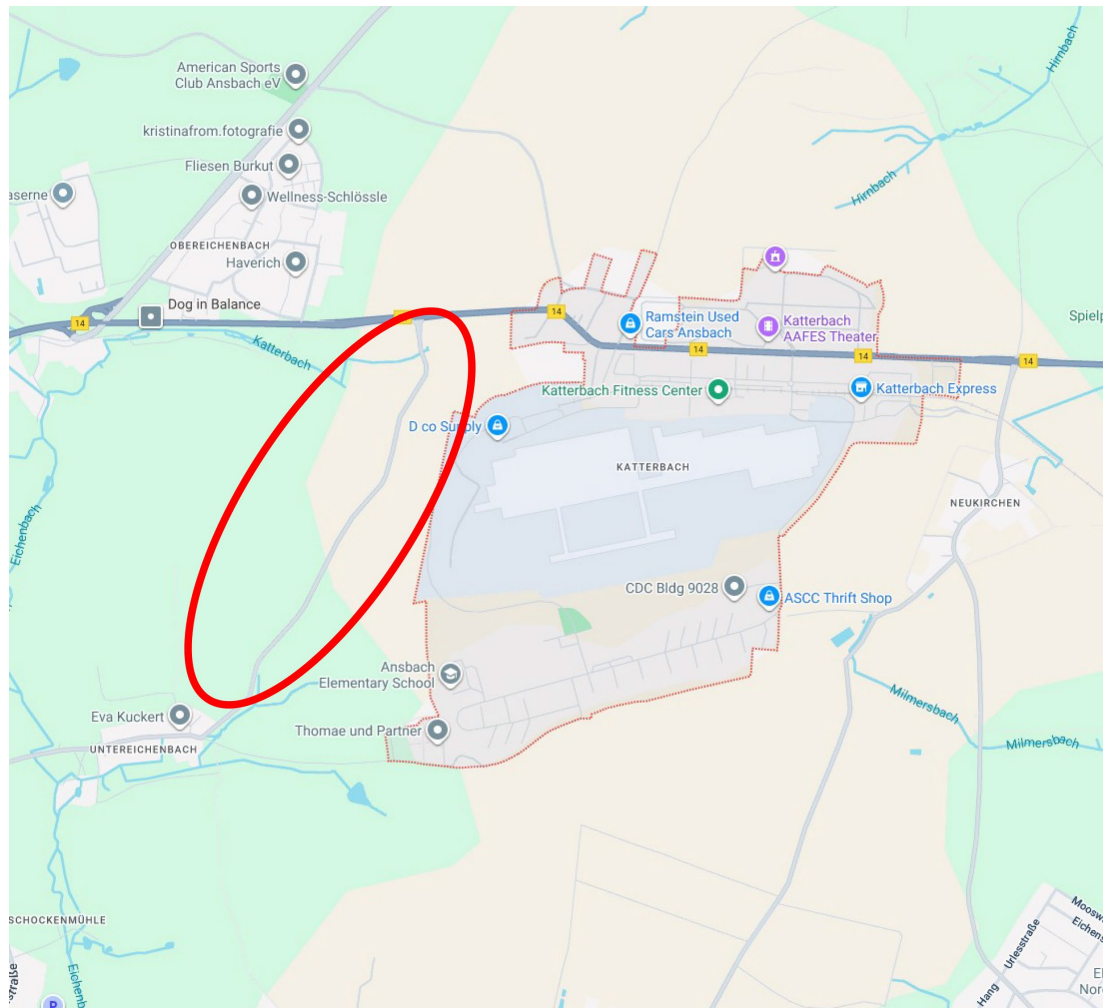

- **What?** Road between Untereichenbach and B14 (Katterbach)
 - **When?** Closed for two years effective 23 SEP 2025.
 - **Why?** Safety concerns, with renovations delayed until 2027 due to funding and land acquisition challenges.
-
- Road has become unsafe due to heavy traffic and deteriorating conditions, prompting the city to enforce a long-term closure.
 - Plans include widening the road to six meters and rebuilding its surface and shoulders.
 - Only buses and agricultural vehicles will be allowed access during the closure, while residents face extended detours.

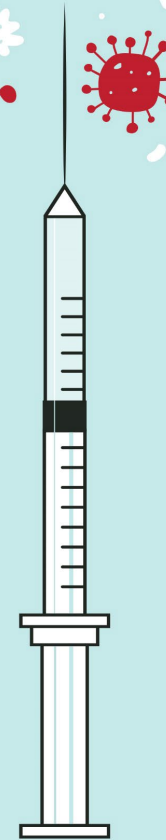

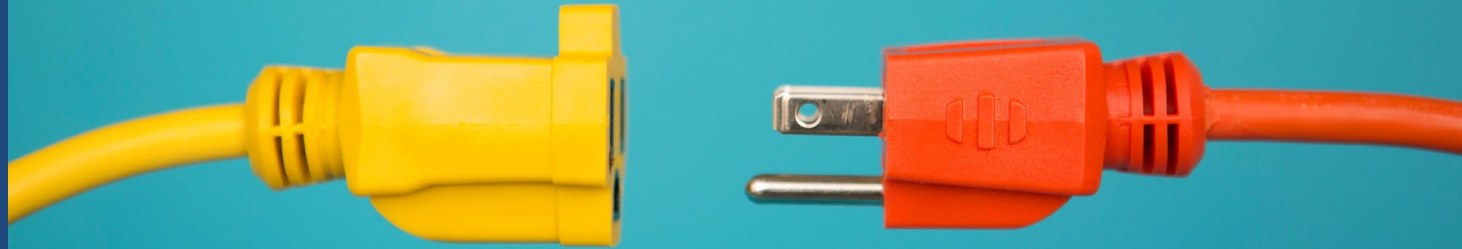
