

# Further loosening in Bavaria as of Monday

The Bavarian cabinet has decided on further relaxations for the Free State from next Monday, June 7 - and also on the lifting of the "disaster situation" that has been in force up to now.

**Contacts:** From Monday, meetings of up to ten people from three households will again be possible in Bavaria if the local incidence is between 50 and 100. If the incidence is below 50, the maximum number of people will remain at ten, but then also from more than three households. Above an incidence value of 100, only meetings between one household and one additional person are allowed. Fully vaccinated and recovered persons as well as children under 14 years of age are not counted here.

**Festivities:** Private festivities such as weddings, birthdays and baptisms can again take place with up to 100 persons outdoors and up to 50 persons indoors (then with a mask, but without mandatory testing) if the local incidence value is below 50. With a local incidence between 50 and 100, celebrations with up to 50 people outdoors and up to 25 people indoors are possible - but then with mandatory testing. Vaccinated and recovered persons and children under the age of 14 are not counted here either.

**Culture & sports:** From Monday, outdoor cultural and sporting events may again be attended by up to 500 visitors, with masks and fixed seating. If the local incidence is over 50, a negative test is also required. At church services, singing will also be permitted again with masks. Furthermore, amateur musicians will again be allowed to rehearse outdoors with no limits on participants, and indoors depending on the size of the room. In addition, from Monday, teams in contact and non-contact sports will again be allowed to practise without limited group sizes if the incidence is below 100. However, a negative test is necessary if the incidence is above 50.

**Hospitality & leisure:** From Monday, indoor hospitality is allowed to open again in Bavaria if the local incidence is below 100 - until midnight. However, if the incidence is above 50, a negative test will be necessary - in addition, fixed hygiene concepts will apply. Furthermore, facilities such as solariums, saunas, indoor swimming pools and amusement parks are allowed to reopen if the incidence is below 100. If the incidence is above 50, however, a negative test is also required there.

**Retail:** Purchases in non-essential retail outlets will again be possible without an appointment from Monday if the local incidence is below 100. However, the mask requirement in shops remains in place.
