

MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Privately Owned Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging at Army-Owned or Leased Family Housing

1. Purpose: Electricity used to charge privately owned electric vehicles by residents of Army-owned or leased family housing at their residential housing complex shall not be differentiated from electricity used for any other purpose.
2. Applicability: This policy applies to the use of electricity by residents to charge privately-owned EVs located at all Army-owned or Army-leased family housing.
3. Effective immediately, this policy authorizes all residents of Army-owned or leased family housing to charge privately-owned EVs without reimbursing the Army for use of the electrical power.
