As the Bavarian government continues lifting its restrictions on public life, so does the gradual easing of protective measures and restrictions for military personnel.

General Order #1B has been rescinded and replaced by General Order #1C, effective June 9.

COVID-19 remains present, and it is imperative that all continue to exercise good judgment and strictly adhere to both U.S. Army and Bavarian rules to protect the health and welfare of our Soldiers, families, civilians and neighbors.

Travel within national borders is now authorized, as long as it is consistent with any host nation restrictions and regulations. There is no longer a mileage restriction within Germany nor a curfew in place:

- Leave and travel is allowed within Germany.
- Travel and leave restrictions are still in place to cross international borders, including to the continental U.S.

Consistent with the Bavarian ordinance and enforceable by German authorities, community members will continue to prioritize reducing physical and social contact with other people - except those in the same household or one other household, as Bavaria retains its two-household rule - to the maximum amount possible. This includes maintaining six feet of physical distancing and continuing the wear of cloth face coverings both on and off the installation.

- Outdoor physical and recreation activities, including team sports involving a group up to five people, are allowed.
- Indoor seating at restaurants is allowed.
- Staying in hotels and using swimming pools is allowed.
- Personnel may travel with one additional household in a personal vehicle.
- Personnel may sign on visitors to the installation.

The following businesses and facilities remain off-limits to community members on and off-post:

 Bars, Night Clubs, Dance Clubs, Hookah Bars, Spas/Gyms and Fitness Studios, Massage Parlors, and Movie Theaters.

Unit chains of command may impose tighter limits than those listed above. Exceptions to above must be signed by a Lieutenant Colonel or above.
