Once the Coronavirus Stimulus Plan is implemented, beware of fraud! These payments will come directly from the Internal Revenue Service. Deal only with the IRS. You can find reliable coronavirus stimulus information on the IRS website.

With few exceptions, official U.S. government sites end in .gov and official U.S. military sites end in .mil. If you encounter a site or email address that does not end in .gov or .mil, seek out one that does.
