# Solid Waste Program - Recycling

## Recycling

Separation of waste is mandatory by German Law. When we recycle, we are protecting our environment and reducing our community's overall waste disposal costs. The USAG Ansbach SORT program describes how residents can help keep the environment clean and to reduce the high cost of disposing of trash.

#### What you Can Do: For more details read the current SORT Brochure

- ✓ Separate your paper dispose it in the paper container.
- ✓ Break down cardboard boxes before disposing them in the paper container.
- Separate your cans and aluminum foil and dispose them in the metal container at the recycling station.
- ✓ Separate your plastics and dispose them in the plastic container at the recycling station.
- ✓ Separate your glass bottles and dispose them in the colored glass container (white-green-brown) at the recycling station, blue, red, or other colors of glass goes in the green container.
- ✓ Do not dispose any bulky items in your regular trash container.
- ✓ Deliver your bulky items, e. g. furniture, electronics, electrical appliances, wooden items, metal items, big Styrofoam parts, etc., to the recycling centers at Katterbach, bldg # 9024, Illesheim, near bldg # 6680.
- ✓ Separate your hazardous waste and deliver them to the recycling center for disposal.
- ✓ Separate your food scraps in the brown Bio container, if available.
- ✓ Separate your yard waste in the brown Bio container, or into the big green waste container provided by the city or village.
- ✓ Do not dispose kitchen grease/oil or any other food into the kitchen drain or toilet!
  - Grease/Oil will clog your pipes—Grease/Oil will attract rats— It generates high repair cost to exchange pipes. Collect grease/oil into a container and bring it to the Recycling Center for disposal.
- ✓ Keep your waste containers closed to keep pests from dispersing trash.
- ✓ Help your new neighbors how to separate waste.
