# **Environmental Reviews**

### **Purpose**

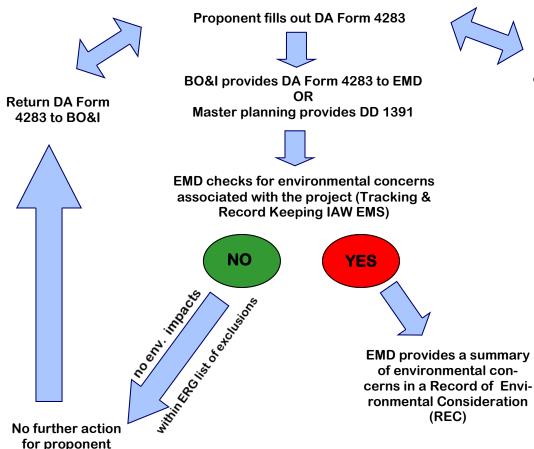
An environmental review is a process that is designed as an early warning system with regards to environmental concerns associated with proposed projects/ activities. This process involves addressing any potential impacts a project or activity might have on the environment and mitigating those impacts prior to project approval. Without an environmental review, a project may incur additional costs associated with the extent of environmental impacts, the project may be delayed, and/ or halted completely.

## **Environmental Review Guide**

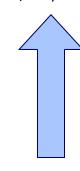
The Environmental Review Guide (ERG) is a software program that is used to help forecast environmental concerns associated with a project or activity and develop mitigation measures to implement within a proposed project. The software allows comparisons of multiple alternatives to determine the project with the least amount of environmental impact through site specific questioning in a variety of technical areas relating to the environment.



#### **Environmental Review Process**
