



Compressed Gas Storage Rules

- Keep out of stairways or narrow passageways, emergency exits, doorways, and hallways
- Do not store in or near areas with public access
- Keep in a ventilated location and secure the cylinders from falling
- Keep the storage area locked
- Apply hazard and mandatory signs
- Keep safety caps on DO NOT THROW THEM AWAY!
- Do not store in basement areas (except compressed gas cylinders containing oxygen)

Remember to keep incompatible gases apart! (i.e. acetylene (flammable) and oxygen (oxidizer))







Examples of **INCORRECT** storage, use and disposal of gas cylinders

REMEMBER:

- Dispensing and maintenance of CGCs are not permitted in storage areas
- Do NOT expose welding facilities and CGCs to heat
 - i.e. minimum distance to open flames (> 1.0 m) and radiators (> 0.5 m)
- CGCs MUST be secure to prevent mechanical damage/ Safety
 - i.e. always chain AND cap
