

2. Aberdeen Proving Ground (APG) is a major research, development, testing, and evaluation installation located in the environmentally sensitive Chesapeake Bay watershed. The fulfillment of this mission depends on our individual and organizational commitment to conserving resources and protecting the environment in which we live and work. To this end, APG supports the mission by integrating sound environmental practices into all of our operations and business decisions.
