


# **Army History Program Mission** (AR 870-5)

Dr. Wernher von Braun

Operation Paperclip was the codename under which the US intelligence and military services extricated scientists from Germany, during and after the final stages of World War II.

- Hitler ordered the SS at Peenemunde to destroy the tons of documents and blueprints.
- Von Braun instructed his personal aide, Dieter Huzel, and Bernhard Tessmann, chief designer of the Peenemunde test facilities, to hide the documents in a safe place.
- On April 3, 1945, all of the documents had been hauled by a small locomotive into an old iron mine in the isolated village of Dornten.

The first seven technicians arrived in the United States at New Castle Army Air Base, just south of Wilmington, Delaware, on September 20, 1945. They were then flown to Boston and taken to the Army Intelligence Service. Later, except for von Braun, the seven men were transferred to Aberdeen Proving Ground in Maryland to translate the 14 tons of documents into English.

These documents would enable the scientists to continue their rocket experiments and ultimately pave the way for America to reach the moon.



U.S. Army Disaster Personnel Accountability and Assessment System (ADPAAS) standardizes a method for the Army to account, assess, manage, and monitor the recovery process for personnel and their families affected and/or scattered by a wide-spread catastrophic event. ADPAAS provides valuable information to all levels of the Army chain of command, allowing commanders to make strategic decisions which facilitate a return to stability.

- ADPAAS allows Army Personnel to do the following:
  - ❖ Report Accounting Status
  - ❖ Update Contact
  - Location Information
  - Complete Needs Assessment
  - **❖ View Reference Information**






