**Dr. Wernher von Braun**

**Operation Paperclip was the codename under which the US intelligence and military services extricated scientists from Germany, during and after the final stages of World War II.**

- Hitler ordered the SS at Peenemunde to destroy the tons of documents and blueprints.
- Von Braun instructed his personal aide, Dieter Huzel, and Bernhard Tessmann, chief designer of the Peenemunde test facilities, to hide the documents in a safe place.
- On April 3, 1945, all of the documents had been hauled by a small locomotive into an old iron mine in the isolated village of Dornten.

The first seven technicians arrived in the United States at New Castle Army Air Base, just south of Wilmington, Delaware, on September 20, 1945. They were then flown to Boston and taken to the Army Intelligence Service. Later, except for von Braun, the seven men were transferred to Aberdeen Proving Ground in Maryland to translate the 14 tons of documents into English. These documents would enable the scientists to continue their rocket experiments and ultimately pave the way for America to reach the moon.

ADPAAS provides valuable information to all levels of the Army chain of command, allowing commanders to make strategic decisions which facilitate a return to stability.

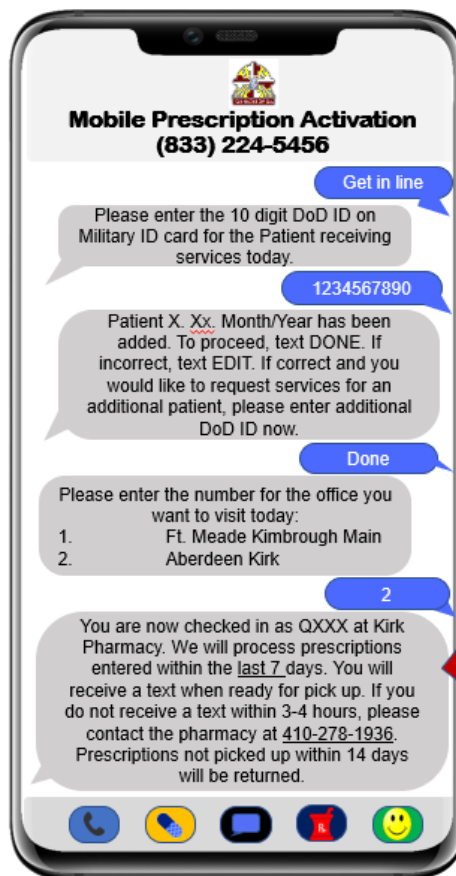

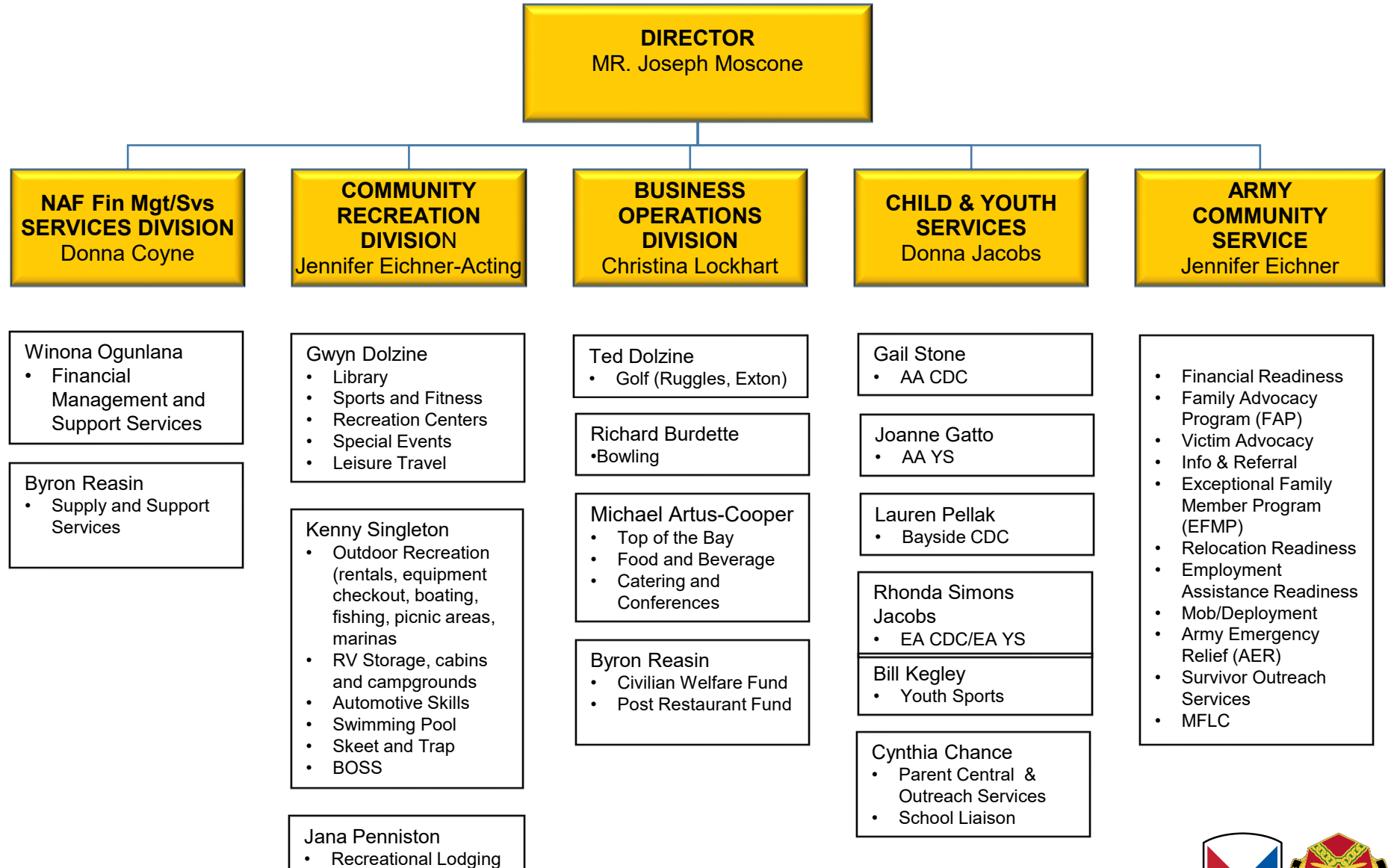

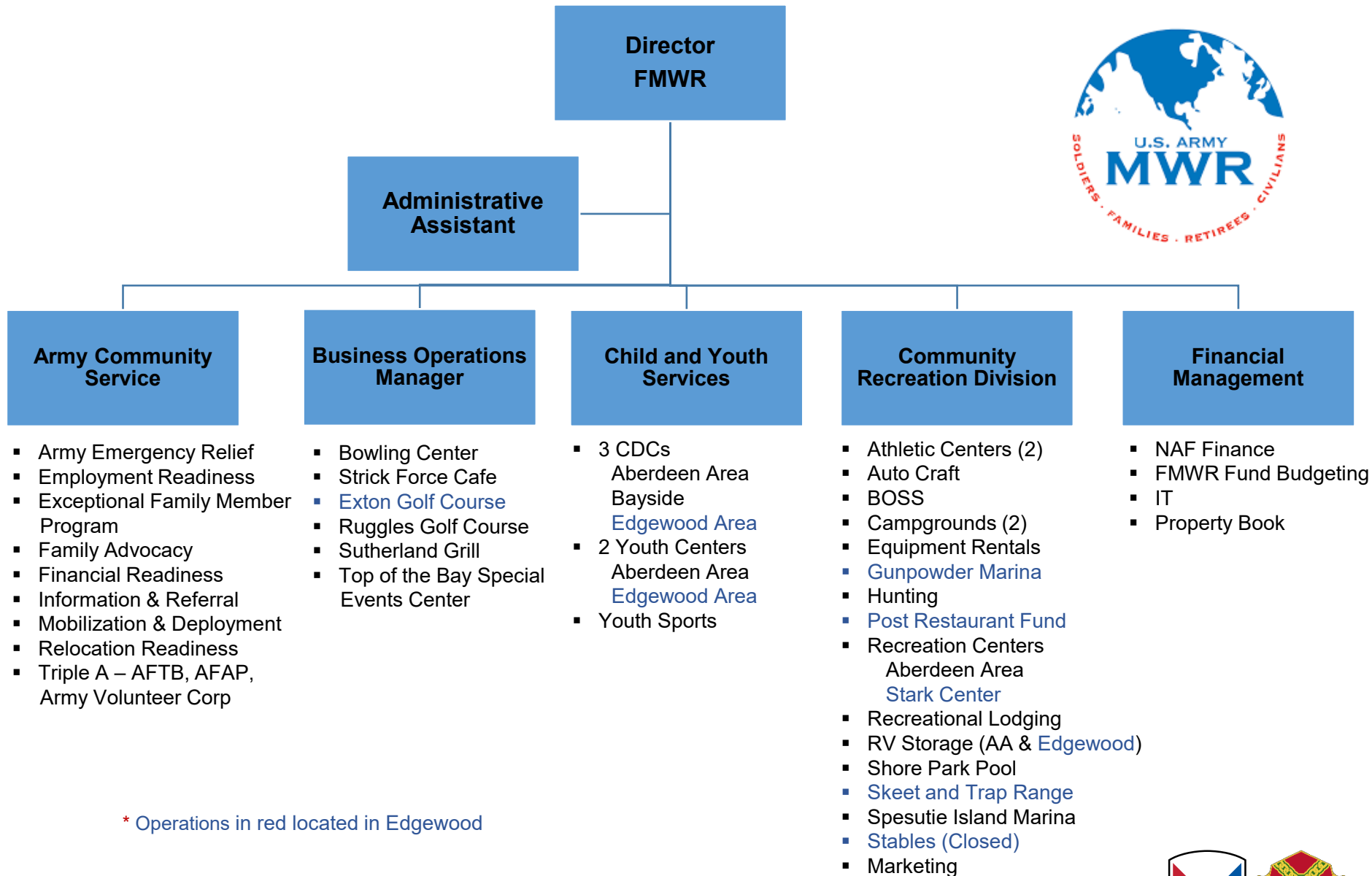
# DFMWR ORGANIZATIONAL CHART

### ARMY VOLUNTEER CORP (AVC)

Mission is to promote and strengthen volunteerism by establishing partnerships to support individual personal growth the life-long volunteer commitment. *VIMS – Volunteer Information Management System support*

### EMPLOYMENT READINESS PROGRAM (ERP)

The mission of ERP is to offer career and job search support. *Services include, job counseling, job search training, employment and educational information*, internet job search and assistance in resume writing.

### EXCEPTIONAL FAMILY MEMBER PROGRAM (EFMP)

## MILITARY FAMILY LIFE COUNSELOR (MFLC)

MFLC provides solution-oriented consultations to support and *assist active-duty Soldiers, National Guard & Reserve, military Family Members, retirees, and civilian personnel.*

## MOBILIZATION/DEPLOYMENT PROGRAM (MOB/DEP)

Program provides the resources for Army Families to equip themselves for Army living. The program is designed to guide and educate Soldiers and Families on how to *manage the complex processes of deployment, reunion and everyday military life.*

## RELOCATION READINESS PROGRAM (RELO)

Comprehensive program designed to assist Soldiers and Families with transfers and relocations throughout the Permanent Change of Station (PCS) cycle. *Includes Lending Closet services.*

## SURVIVOR OUTREACH SERVICES (SOS)

Must contact the **EEO** Office within **45 calendar days** of the alleged act or becoming aware of the alleged discriminatory act to initiate the complaint process. *Contacting EEO does not mean you automatically file a complaint.*
