Question: There is projection of 1300 vehicles as well as linehaul arriving for CBR26-05, what impacts to the community and gates 1,3, and 5 are there?

- Starting on 27 JAN 26 to 6 FEB 2026 line haul arrives, personnel are advised to either use Gate 1 or Gate 3 during this time..
- We have mitigated steps and advised a plan to avoid a backup or influx of linehaul vehicles extending out to ST2234. Linehaul trucks will be brought into the extended portion of Gate 5 for inspections to elevate congestion at gate 5.
- Hours of operations for linehaul will be mostly between 0700-1900 daily. There will be times that linehaul shows up outside of operations hours and we be handled by white cell and ponds.
- School busses and busses with military personnel and family show avoid Gate 5 during this time and use Gate 1.

Question: In-processing has been moved from building 10 to 309, what is the plan in place to get Soldiers/families from lodging to building 309?

- There is a bus stop on General Patton drive right in front of the current lodging, that bus stops by the shoppette and from there is only 300M walk to building 309.

Question: Volksfest is scheduled from 29 APR to 04 May 2026, with CBR 26-07 going on at that time are we going to cancel it for this year?

- JMRC and 1-4 INF will be heavily engaged in **CBR 26-07** and won't be able to assist the Garrison during the fest.
- There is current construction going on at the Fest Platz and might not be completed by 29 APR 2026 due to issues that may arise.
- DoDEA HMHS will have construction going on during **29 APR to 04 May 2026 and the parking lot will be full of construction equipment and won't be available for the Volksfest Box Tours.**
- Currently USAG Bavaria-Hohenfels Gate 1 construction isn't scheduled until 22 June 26 and ACP 1 Alpha isn't scheduled until 20 July 2026.

Question: Can we increase illumination at the crosswalks by the Zone.

- DPW is working on added new streetlights to this area for better visibility.

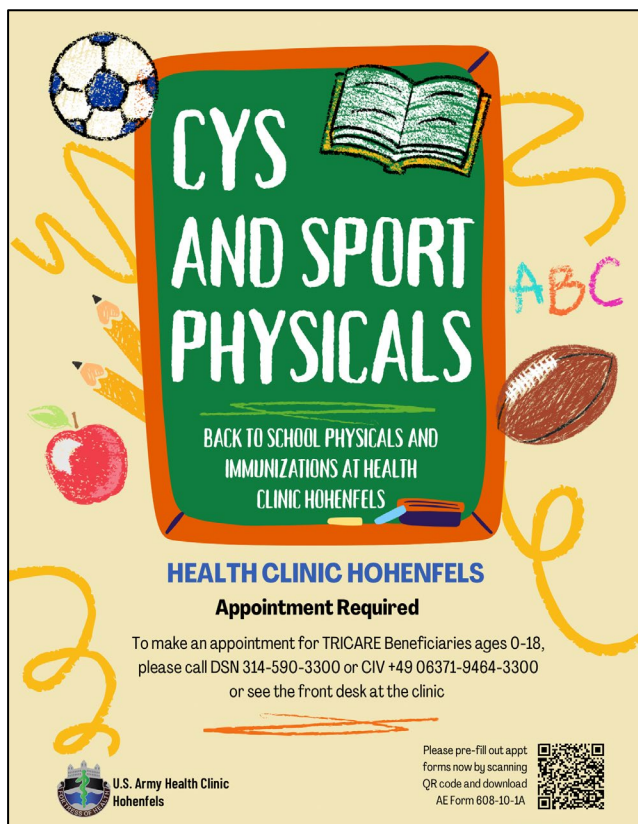

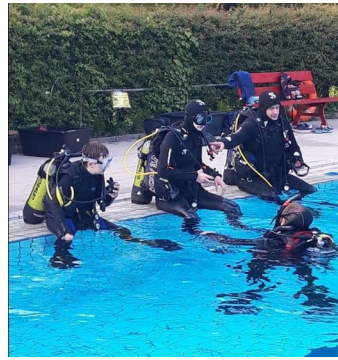
