To re-register your student, locate the **Student Re-registration** widget and click the **Initiate** button. Next choose the student you would like to re-register.







In the drop-down box at the bottom of the screen the parent will either choose either withdrawing or staying in the same location.




If withdrawing, after indicating you will be moving, press submit, and you are finished.


