German Police and Military Police

A highly disciplined, well trained and professional Police force



German Police work closely with U.S. MP; you must follow German Police commands and directives off post

(MUST IDENTIFY)



- German Police may draw blood if suspicion of DUI/DWI exists
- Will detain service member until MP arrive



DRIVING IN EUROPE 1 / 2



- * After market window tint is illegal on front windows and windshield
- * Vehicles can not have US Forces affiliation shown i.e. ERB window, dealership name, etc.



* Winter tires/AS are required when snow/ice is present on the road (NLT 31OCT), M/S rated tires are acceptable. Winter Tires must have 6 mm tread depth, AS tires at least 4 mm with mountain symbol, MS with mountain and snowflake

* License plates must be secured in bracket or screws. No 550 cord or Zip Ties





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DRIVING IN EUROPE 2 / 2

➤ License Requirements

➤ USAREUR Driver's License

-Drivers are **REQUIRED** to have a USAREUR license if operating a USAREUR registered vehicle; 1st offense will result to 6 points assessed to driving record. Second offense results in an apprehension (ART 92 UCMJ)



- Vehicle Accidents

- off post report immediately to the German Police, and then report to MP Station
- Failure to report will result in being titled with either "Failure to report an accident" or "Fleeing the scene of an accident"



* Cell phone use (without a hands free device) is prohibited;
mandatory 7 day drivers license suspension

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Traffic Collision Reporting Requirements

Reporting Requirements for all Traffic Collisions on Military Installations:

- All traffic collisions will be reported to Military Police **immediately** at 09641-70-4677 or 09641-70-4678, regardless of POV or GOV involvement
- Training areas are considered part of the Military Installation and Military Police will be contacted using the same criteria as above

Reporting Requirements Outside of Military Installations:

- All traffic collisions will be reported to Host Nation Police **immediately at 110**, regardless of POV or GOV involvement
- Traffic collisions involving a GOV (Tactical or Non-Tactical) will be reported to the nearest Military Police Station **immediately** at 09641-70-4677 or 09641-70-4678
- Traffic collisions involving a POV must be reported to the nearest Military Police Station **within 72 hours** in person. Failure to do so, can result in “Failure to report”
- Regardless of where the traffic collisions drivers should exchange telephone #'s, Names, insurance companies (Versicherung), and Names

Traffic Violations

- Inside city limit the speed limit is 50 KPH (note: there are dedicated 30 KPH zones within some city limits)
- Outside city limits the speed limit is 100 KPH
- Autobahn recommended speed limit is 130 KPH, above that you may be held liable if accident occurs, even if you are not at fault



- Look out for posted speed zones, cameras are used by German Police to catch violators

Speeding tickets range from 20 - 680 euros!

- On post, if speed limit is not posted, the speed limit is 30 KPH

- Display Parking Disc when in timed parking

Parking tickets up to 30 euros!





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DD Form 1408

- USAREUR has a driver's points system
- **12 points in one year or 18 points in two years will result in a suspension of your license**
- Commanders will assess points accumulated off post and on post together

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Operating Under Influence

.05 G/100ML (BAC) TO .079 G/100ML (BAC) = **DUI - AER 190-1**

- 3 Month Suspension of Drivers License
- Assessment of 6 Traffic Points

SM under 21 with ANY BAC up to .049 G/100ML (BAC) while driving will receive 30 day suspension (60 day for 2nd, 90 day for 3rd offense)

.08 G/100ML (BAC) or higher = **Drunken Driving - ART 113 UCMJ**

- Revocation of Drivers License
- Assessment of 6 Traffic Points

Operating a POV with a BAC .05 or more for a second offense within the last 5 year period is an automatic 5 year revocation

NOTE: You Can Receive A DWI/DUI Charge In Germany While Operation A Bike Or Electric Shooter Under The Influence.

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ACCESS TO ARMY INSTALLATIONS 1 / 5

• Installation Access

1. A DOD Identification (ID) Card must be presented to the Access Control Point (ACP) guard to access the Installation.
2. When DBID is offline, A second form of photo ID, i.e. passport or state side driver license/ID, must be presented to the ACP guard.
3. If DOD personnel forget their ID Card, some ACPs have the capability to perform a manual look in DBIDS. Manual look up requires two forms of photo ID to be presented to the ACP guard.
4. All personnel/vehicles entering a DoD Installation are subject to Random Anti-Terrorism Measures. To included, but not limited to, vehicle searches and additional ID verification (second form of photo ID).

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ACCESS TO ARMY INSTALLATIONS 2 / 5

• **Escorted-Visitor Paper Pass**

1. DOD ID Card Holders who are 18 years or older and Military Spouses under the age of 18 are authorized sign in privileges.
2. Sponsors are authorized to obtain a Escorted-Visitor Paper Pass up to 30 days for their visitors.
3. Sponsors are authorized to escort up to 10 visitor at any one time.
4. All visitors must have valid ID or Passports, U.S. Citizens over the age of 17 years old must provide their social security number.
5. Any visitor with an outstanding “Want and Warrants” or “Barred” will be denied access on the installation.



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ACCESS TO ARMY INSTALLATIONS 3 / 5

• **Escorted-Visitor Paper Pass: Sponsors Responsibility**

1. Ensure that their visitors are physically escorted at all times.
2. Visitors will physically be signed out prior to midnight of the date printed on the Escorted-Visitor Paper Pass at the gate that was issued.
3. Sponsors or Visitors failing to comply will result in the revocation of their sign-in privileges. First offense 30 days, second offense 120 days and third offense 1 year.



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ACCESS TO ARMY INSTALLATIONS 4 / 5

• Access Roster

1. All DOD ID card holders (CAC and dependent) with Visitor-Sponsor Privileges may submit an Access Roster Request using AE Form 190-16F.
2. Access roster are for events only, i.e. Birthday Parties and unit organizational day.
3. Sponsors may submit access roster requests to the Installation Access Control Office at Bldg. 244 on Tower Barracks or the IAC Office at Bldg. 1701 on Rose Barracks. usarmy.bavaria.id-europe.list.des-iacs@army.mil
4. All access rosters requests must be submitted at least three working days prior to the effective date, weekly on Tuesdays and Fridays.
5. Access rosters are posted at all Access Control Points on Tower and Rose Barracks.
6. Not authorized for regular visitor access. Must utilize Escorted-Visitor Pass or Long-Term Visitor (Family Member) request.



ACCESS TO ARMY INSTALLATIONS 5 / 5

• Long-Term Visitors – Immediate Family Members

1. All DOD ID card holders (CAC and dependent) may request for unescorted Installation access for visiting family members using AE Form 190-16A and Military Enclave Installation list.
2. Family members must provide a copy of their Passports
3. U.S. Citizens over the age of 17 years must provide a copy of their social security card.
4. U.S. Citizens must undergo a U.S. background check.
5. Access may be granted up to 90 days.
6. If sponsor resides on the installation, provide a copy of Housing agreement
7. If sponsor resides off the installation Commander/Director memorandum stating requestor has an extenuating circumstances requiring visitor to have unescorted access
