SUBJECT: USAG Bavaria Policy Memorandum #20, Protecting Special Events and Off- Installation Activities

2. General. This policy reissues and cancels USAG Bavaria Policy Memorandum #20, dated 27 June 2023 which establishes procedures for protecting special events and trips conducted on and off U.S. controlled installations. For purposes of this memorandum, the term "special events" will encapsulate all of these activities.

3. USAG Bavaria and its mission partners must exercise due diligence to identify the threat and take appropriate steps to mitigate potential risks to our personnel. Off installation events present especially lucrative, soft targets, to would-be attackers. Special events conducted on U.S. controlled installations require diligence and risk mitigation measures as well. All on and off post special events and trips will have the appropriate AT/FP approval in accordance with the enclosed Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) prior to execution. These special events include unique and/or recurring off-installation events such as unit/organizational activities, Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR), United Services Organization (USO), and Better Opportunities for Single Soldier (BOSS).

4. Special events merit a deliberate planning process. This process consists of a current threat assessment of the area where the event will occur and a risk assessment to identify hazards and recommend measures to mitigate risk to an acceptable level.
