Shipping a POV from Germany (Out-Processing):

*****NOTE: You must drop vehicle off at shipping location prior to deregistering or obtaining Transition plates. Please see our outprocessing flowchart for more information.**

- Valid ID Card
- Valid U.S. Forces Certificate of License or Temporary US Forces Certificate of License
- Current registration and Plates
- Credit / Debit Card or Check / Money Order made payable to "USAREUR Registration Fund"
- Shipping Orders / Shipping Document / Bill of Lading

Motorcycle Shipping with your Households Goods

- Household Goods Inventory Sheet, that shows the motorcycle, the plate number and the VIN
- The plate
- Valid Registration

Driving to Belgium, Netherlands, England or other country

- Provide a copy of your PCS Orders to new duty station
- The Plates
- Valid Registration

Personnel reassigned to another duty station in Germany

- You will keep the German Plates and USAREUR Registration
- Report to your local RMV station
- Must provide new ICC (Insurance confirmation Card) to change Plates and registration due on your new Duty Station, within 30 days upon arrival at new duty station
- Provide a copy of your PCS Orders to new duty station and your the set of plates from your previous garrison

NOTES:

- You will NOT receive Transition plates if your vehicle is shipped as non operational!
- QQ plates are not available for Vehicles shipped by an agent
- Privately shipped - Shipping documents & condition report; A booking confirmation is not a valid shipping document and will not be accepted!
- Transition Plates (QQ plates): Will be free of charge, unless the current registration has less than 90 days of valid time before transition plates request date. - Cost is \$45.00

Please ensure all mandatory items listed above are present when conducting your transaction.
