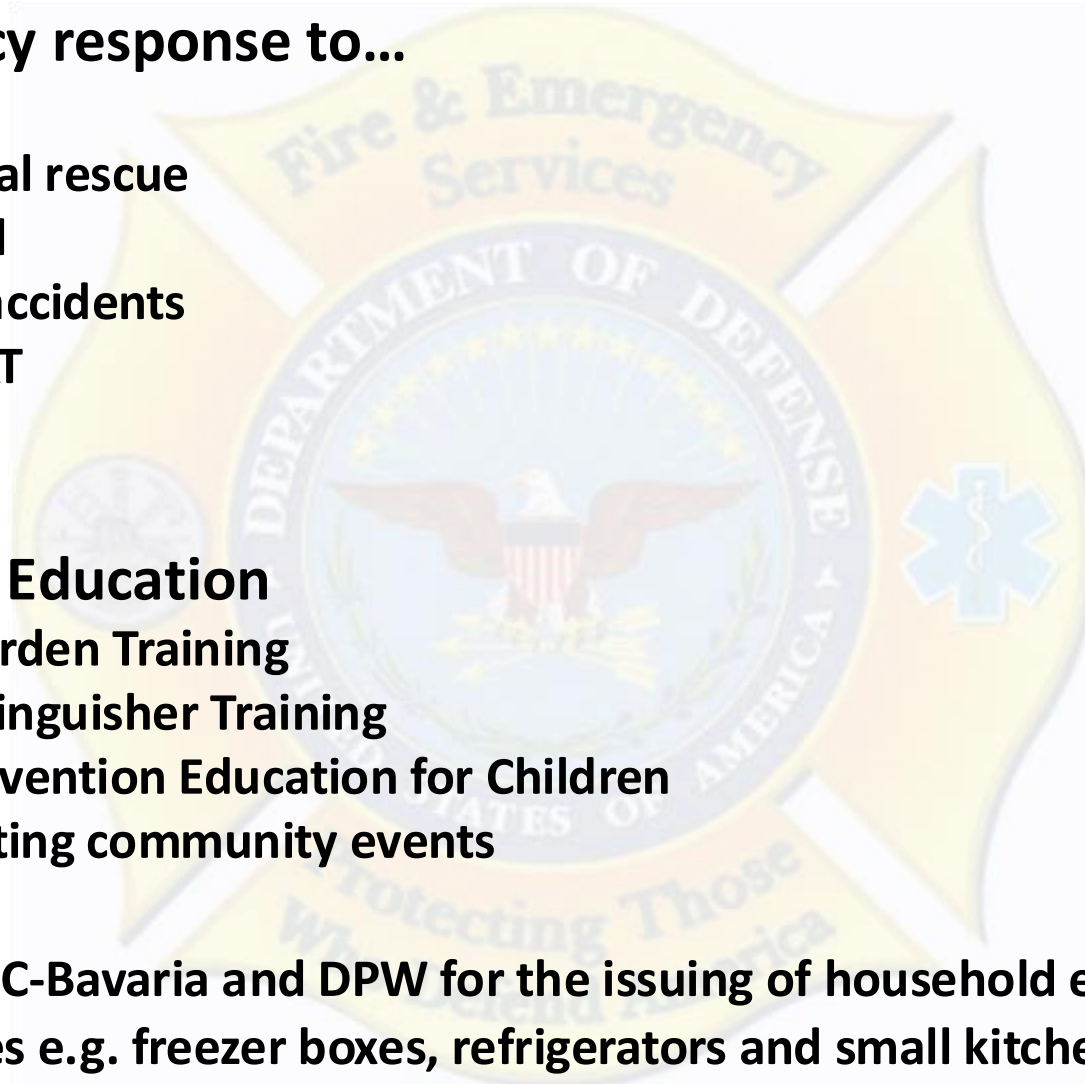

Reporting an Emergency

- W**hat happened?
- W**hat is involved?
- W**here did it happen?
- W**as anybody injured? (number of injuries)
- W**ait for further questions from the operator!

Smoke Alarms



Smoke Detectors Can Save Your Life If they are Properly Maintained!

- Test your smoke detector monthly (If **not** connected to a building fire alarm system)
- Replace batteries at least once a year (If required)
- Clean your smoke detector regularly
- **Always** react to the alarm of the smoke detector



Kitchenfire

- if the fire gets out of control, follow your evacuation procedure
- never try to move a burning pan !!!
- always have the appropriate lid available while cooking
- in case of fire put a lid on the pan, turn off the stove and wait until it's cooled down
- never use water or flour, to extinguish a grease fire
- once you turned on the stove, stay in the kitchen

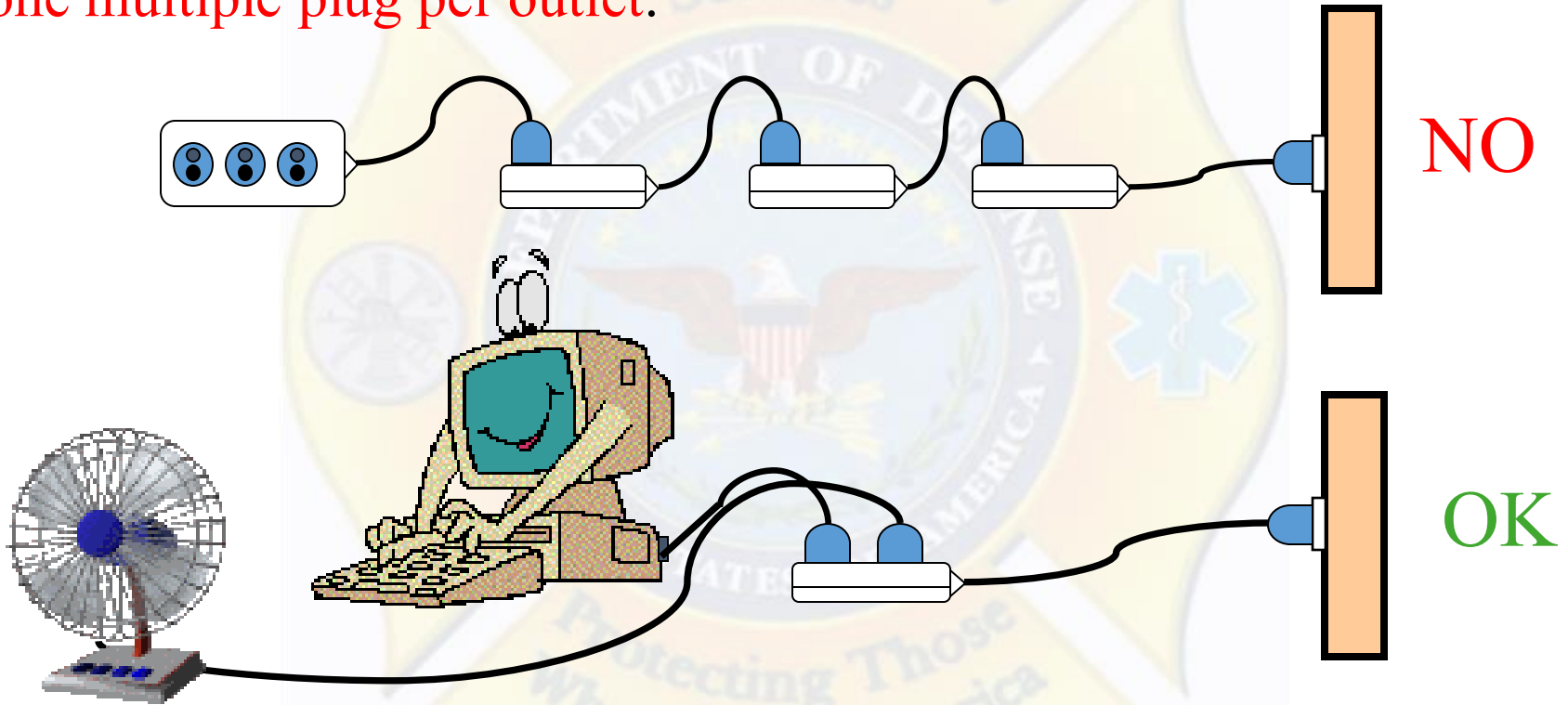


Do NOT use Stove as a heater!!!



Electrical Safety

Do not overload extension cords or building wiring by connecting several multiple plug cords in series or more than **one multiple plug per outlet**.



Only one multiple plug or extension cord per wall outlet.



Fire Doors

In the event of a fire, they stop fire and smoke spreading into corridors and stairs
- provided they are kept shut.



BBQ - Rules

- no grilling on balconies
- grills must be on a solid soil and never left unattended
- stay away at least 5 feet from any structure, trees, bushes, etc. (further away if windy)
- never pour flammable liquids on glowing or burning charcoal
- use only approved equipment on gas grills
- make sure, all screw joints are leak-proof
