MEMORANDUM FOR All USAG Bavaria Military and Civilian Personnel, and Family Members

SUBJECT: USAG Bavaria Policy Memorandum #12, AAFES Exchange Privilege Suspension

1. Reference Army Regulation 215-8, Army and Air Force Exchange Service Operations.
2. This policy memorandum, applicable to all persons afforded Exchange privileges within USAG Bavaria, is intended to ensure good order and discipline and to prevent abuse of AAFES privileges in accordance with AR 215-8.
3. Upon receipt of credible information that an individual with AAFES privileges has committed the offense(s) of larceny, theft, shoplifting or employee pilferage of AAFES property or presentation, the individual will have his or her AAFES privileges immediately suspended by the Directorate of Emergency Services (DES), pending the final outcome of investigation by the DES and adjudication of the offense by the individual's commander or the Civilian Misconduct Action Authority (CMAA).
 - a. Individuals found not to have committed the offense of larceny, theft, shoplifting or employee pilferage, of AAFES property by their commander or the CMAA will have their AAFES privileges reinstated.
 - b. Individuals found by their commander or the CMAA to have committed the offense of larceny of AAFES property will have their AAFES privileges revoked across the USAG Bavaria enterprise for a minimum of six months.
4. Individuals who have had their AAFES privileges revoked may appeal the revocation to the Garrison Commander or the next higher commander who may reinstate exchange privileges for cogent and compelling reasons IAW AR 215-8 paragraph 7-6e.
