STORE CONCEPT:

1. The Expanded Self-Help Program is designed to use available manpower resources more effectively by encouraging troop units and Government housing occupants to conserve utilities, to follow good housekeeping practices, and to perform simple maintenance and repair work (within their capabilities) to supplement the DEH maintenance and repair efforts. No electrical work is authorized except as specified below, i.e. replacing light bulbs, fluorescent tubes, fuses and user preventive maintenance of appliances and kitchen equipment.

2. Your store is also a drop off point for all of your Household Hazardous Waste. The store staff can provide you with a list of these items. Organic waste baskets are located at, or near all quarters on post during the summer months. Organic waste can also be brought to the store, to extend the life of our sanatoria land fill. Organic wastes are leafs, tree branches and grass clippings.

3. If during your visit there is any thing you need or would like to see in your store, don't hesitate to let the staff know. The Warehouse house has items that are not stocked in the store but can be obtained if a need should exist. If an item is not in stock then just fill out one of our want slips and we will call you when that item is available.

SELF HELP GUIDANCE
Types of work Occupants should perform

Refasten coat hooks, clothes poles closet shelves.

Tighten/adjust/lubricate/replace builders hardware, e.g., hinges, handles, screws, door stops, etc.

Install minor accessories, e.g., paper towel holders, bathroom shelf or towel racks.

Painting (use approved pastel color)

Replace caulking around doors, windows and bathroom fixtures.

Install/remove/clean/repair window and door screens.

Replace curtain and shower rods.

Minor kitchen cabinet repairs/adjust drawers.

Minor pest control.

Fire prevention practices.

Routine plumbing maintenance and repairs (e.g., leaky faucet, clogged toilet, winter drainage of exterior water lines, etc.)

Clean/replace light fixtures and bulbs, replace switch and receptacle covers, reset breakers, cleaning and routine maintenance of government appliances (e.g., filter cleaning or replacement, regular defrosting), and total responsibility for personnel appliances.

Grounds maintenance around building including greenery, cleanup, snow/ice removal. In stairwell units, building coordinators will distribute such work equitably.

The following material and products are, or contain hazardous material. These generic items are categorized into one more of five major areas; corrosive (C), flammable (F), noxious (N), reactive (R), and toxic (T) wastes. When disposed all of the following items considered household hazardous waste:

- * Wrap the waste in newspapers and place in a double plastic bag.
- * Store in an out-of-the way location, away from children, pets, heat, and water.
- * Never mix different chemicals.
