Why is handling waste so important in your Army Housing?

As a member of Army Housing, every day, normal living, you produce different types of waste, like plastic-, organic- or such bulk trash. Be proactive to handle waste appropriately and take measures to reduce it. Reducing waste and handling it correctly saves taxpayer's money and decrease your carbon footprint.



When possible, reuse your products, or maintain and repair products like clothing, tires and appliances. This way they will not need to be thrown out and replaced as frequently. If it is not possible to reuse your purchased products, then make sure to recycle it. Recycling conserves natural resources such as timber, water and mined materials. The reuse and repurposing of products prevents pollution by reducing the need to collect and process new raw materials and transporting waste.

6 tips to handling waste

- 1. Reduce your waste.** Look for products which use less packaging. When manufacturers make their products with less packaging, they use less raw material. These extra savings can be passed along to the consumer. For example, buying in bulk can reduce packaging and save money.
- 2. Reuse your waste** or buy reusable over single-use items. Look for items that can be reused or repurposed; the little things can add up.
- 3. Compost your waste.** When you mow your grass or cut your greenery bring the green waste to the Rose Barracks Green Waste Collection Point or the Tower Barracks Compost Yard. This reduces landfill space, saving tax payer money.
- 4. Store and dispose of household hazardous materials responsibly.** After use, items such as fuel, drip pans, batteries, and other hazardous material should never be left unsecured outside the home, such as your carport, or disposed in the trash bins or sinks. Bring them to the designated disposal sites.

5. Use the on-post hazardous waste collection point.

Designated collection sites such as Self Help and FMWR Auto Skills Center are available to receive household hazardous waste such as fuel, drip pans, used motor oil, and other items.

6. Use the on-post and off-Post local bulk waste collection points.

Bring all bulk trash to one of the two available recycling centers on post or use the spring and fall Housing clean-up days. Off post disposal instructions can be found on the garrison SORT Coordinator page.
