Although there has been no increase in the current security posture in our area, personnel are encouraged to exercise good sound personal protective measures.

- Travel in small groups and vary routes/times.
 - Let your unit, coworker, family, and/or battle buddy know where you're going/itinerary.
 - Be inconspicuous and don't wear clothing with US or DoD affiliation.
 - Avoid talking loudly or drawing attention to yourself.
 - Remove any DoD or US affiliated stickers from your vehicle.
 - Remove any DoD or US affiliated stickers from your vehicle.
 - Be aware of your surroundings and potential safe havens (i.e., police station, hospital).
 - Avoid gatherings or demonstrations and depart if one is encountered.
 - Know emergency numbers and other important numbers (i.e. nearest US Consulate).
 - When possible, carry a cell phone and pre-program emergency numbers.
 - Monitor available media, including news and government websites, and social networking sites (such as --"Stay Safe Antiterrorism" on Facebook) for information while traveling.

- Be cautious in high risk areas such as hotel lobbies, nightclubs, mass – transit hubs...
 - Register with State Department's Smart Traveler Enrollment Program to receive alerts and messages for your duty station and travel destinations.
 - Maintain a "low profile." Try to blend in with the local populace through how you dress and your appearance -- especially when traveling abroad.
 - Understand the culture where you are traveling and learn basic survival phrases (such as "I need a police officer" and "I need a doctor").
 - Avoid civil disturbances or demonstrations of any kind – these events can turn

violent with little to no advanced warning.

Know before you go this summer

People scheduled to move to the States this summer should start preparing now by separating things that are banned from import and finding new homes for them. It is also a good idea to apply early for import permits on restricted items, customs officials advise. Prohibited items include meat and meat products such as sausage, pâté and salami, as well as plants, plant products and all destructive devices, said Tim Sellman, director of the U.S. European Command's Customs and border Clearance Agency. Explosive caps, tear gas projectiles, artillery simulators, fireworks, etc. are examples of destructive devices, he added. If you are planning on shipping firearms, ensure you have proof that you owned them in the States or have an import permit, he went on. Sellman also explained that other important points to remember are: - Owners of vehicles not made to U.S. standards have to ship them through commercial importers registered with the Department of Transportation and Environmental Protection Agency. However, vehicles more than 25 years old are exempt from this rule. - Most mopeds and motorcycles must also meet U.S. safety and pollution standards, and all vehicles must be free of dirt, insects and vegetation. - Wine collections can only be shipped with advance approval from the transportation office. - Endangered species items such as ivory and some furs may only be shipped if owners can prove they were previously owned in the U.S., or are antiques over 100 years old. - State attorneys general must approve imports of gambling devices. These devices must be registered with the Justice Department in Washington, D.C. Need more details? Stop by your transportation office or your local military customs office.

A Command-Sponsored dependent departs the permanent duty station vicinity for a period of 31 or more consecutive calendar days then OCONUS COLA payment beginning on the 31st day is reduced to the rate for the number of command-sponsored dependents remaining at the PDS.

One or more command-sponsored dependents depart the PDS vicinity for early or advance return then COLA is reduced to without dependent or barracks rate.

If your marital status has changed then your military pay account with Finance would need to be updated. The first step to update all these changes is to see your Unit S-1 office.
