Netzaberg Recycling Points

Henry- Kissinger-Strasse
Containers for cardboard, metal cans, glass, clothes and yard waste

Roemersbuehl Strasse
Containers for cardboard, metal cans and glass

Kapellenweg
Containers for cardboard, metal cans and glass



Put Waste in its place

It is prohibited by Host Nation law to bring of refuse on post to be disposed of.

Exceptions: Hazardous waste

Fluorescent light bulbs, bleaches, pesticides, motor oil, propane gas containers etc. should be brought to the DPW Self Help Store Bldg. #394

Electronics

TV's, microwaves, vacuum cleaners, printers, etc. can be brought to the Tower Barracks Recycling Center Bldg. #441

Bulk Trash

Wooden furniture, upholstered furniture, plastic furniture, mattresses, carpets, rugs, suitcases etc. can be brought to the Tower Barracks Recycling Center Bldg. #441

Recyclables

Cardboard, metal, yellow bag, glass, clothes can be brought to the Tower Barracks Recycling Center Bldg. #441

County specific refuse trash bags are available to purchase at the Tower Barracks Express location (\$ 4.50 per bag). The trash bags can be placed curbside, next to your trash bin and will get picked up by the county.

Yellow bags for plastics are available at the Self Help Store Bldg. #394 (free of charge).

Curbside Bulk trash pickup at Netzaberg in Spring and Fall

Bulk trash can always be brought to the Tower Barracks Recycling Center Bldg. #441, near Gate 6.
