Host nation medical facilities resume normal services

VILSECK Germany -- All host nation medical facilities have resumed normal services as of May 18, 2020. Host nation hospitals are updating their social media websites with the most current information.

The following area medical facilities continue to maintain the following restrictions:

Ansbach and Rothenburg: Patients may be visited during regular visiting hours, between 3 p.m. to 6 p.m., by a designated contact person only. The designated contact person must remain the same – the person cannot change.

Visits are only allowed for one hour per day.

Upon entering the hospital, the visitor has to sign-in and state that he or she has “no symptoms.” Hospital staff may ask to see identification.

Scheduled inpatient care is possible.

Amberg: Visitors are allowed in the hospital. Visiting hours are from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. with last entry at 5:30 p.m. All visitors need to enter at the main entrance. Visits are only allowed for one hour per day. Please note wearing a face mask or face cloth covering and maintaining at least six feet social distancing is a must.

Patients will have to provide visitors names. Visitors will have to fill out a form when they come in.

Pediatric patients can be visited by both parents. One parent may stay with the child.

When patients give birth, the father may stay during the delivery and is then allowed to visit mother and baby for up to two hours per day. Siblings (kids), unfortunately, are not allowed to visit.

Any patient who is COVID-19 positive is not allowed to be visited.

Klinik Hallerwiese Nuernberg and Cnopfsche Kinderklinik Nuernberg: Patients may be visited during regular visiting hours, between 2 p.m. to 6 p.m., by a designated contact person only. The designated contact person must remain the same – the person cannot change.

Please note wearing a face mask or face cloth covering and maintaining at least six feet social distancing is mandatory.

Sulzbach-Rosenberg: Visitors are allowed during regular visiting hours, between 2 p.m. to 7 p.m., however, patients may be visited once a day by a designated contact person only. This designated contact person will be identified at the time of admission and will have to fill out a form every time he or she visits the patient. No children are allowed.

Upon entering the hospital, visitors must wear a face mask or face cloth covering and maintain at least six feet of social distancing. Visitors are expected to wash and disinfect their hands when arriving at the hospital, and before entering and leaving the patient's room.

Weiden: Only 60 visitors total are allowed per hour to visit inpatients at the hospital. The relationship between the patient and the visitor will be validated.

Only one visitor per patient for no more than 45 minutes per day is allowed.

No children are allowed. The only exception are children less than 7 years old may accompany the visitor to visit the patient.

The hospital prefers to only have patients arrive for outpatient referrals, but understands if a guest needs to accompany the patient.

The underground parking garages are closed. Surface parking is available but you must pay (bring Euro coins with you).
