

Army Compensation & Entitlements



The New AR 637-1 Army Compensation and Entitlements Policy

Changed to the frequency of Soldiers Pay. Effective 1 October 2022.

- All Soldiers will be paid twice per month. Soldiers being paid once per month will continue to be paid once per month until the pay period ending 30 September 2022.
- Effective 1 October 2022 all Soldiers who have not changed their election to twice per month will be automatically switched to twice per month. End of Month only will no longer be an option.
- All new pay elections SF 1199A (Direct Deposit Sign-up Form) will be for the twice a month option only."

DES Child Safety and Supervision

- Children under the age of 12 or less than 150 cm (4 feet 11 inches) require the use of a child-restraint system suitable for the child.
- Children must ride in the back seat of vehicles.
- Supervision:

U.S.ARMY

- Age 0-4. Must be under direct contact at all times.
- Age 5. Must be within site of adult at all times.
- Age 6. May be left outside (daytime) in playgrounds/yards.
- Age 7-9. May walk to/from school.
 - May be left outside (daytime) in playgrounds/yards.
- Age 10-11. May be left at home not to exceed 3 hours.
 - May left in vehicle unattended up to 10 min., except in hot weather. (Keys must be removed and hand break applied.)
- Age 12-13. May be left at home up to 6 hours.
 - Can babysit up to 3 hours.
- Age 14-17 years. May be left home.
 - Overnight (14-15 up to 24 hrs.) (16-17 up to 3 consecutive days w/ adult POC making face to face contact)

Fire safety shouldn't stop when you leave your home. Carelessness outdoors can have fatal results.

- Extinguish cigarettes and other smoking materials properly.
- Never throw cigarette ends out of car windows.
- Avoid using open fires in the countryside.
- Only use barbecues in a suitable and safe area and never leave them unattended.

What to do if you see a fire?

- Report it immediately to your local Fire and Rescue Service (Dial 112).
- Do not try to tackle the fire if it can't be put out with a bucket of water leave the area as quickly as possible, and preferably move downhill as a fire will spread more quickly uphill.







Vehicle Registration



- Temporary Tags are only authorized for up to 30 days or until the day you pass inspection and will not be issued more than twice consecutively for the same vehicle.
- Cancelled temporary registrations must be registered as nonoperational. An additional registration fee is required for the nonoperational transaction.
- Failure to return temp tags within the 30 days, **or date of inspection**, will result in loss of registration privileges:
 - For every day late = two days of registration privileges suspended
 - 30+ days late = 60 days plus fees
 - Vehicle must pass inspection before permanent USAREUR plates issued
 - All POVs must be inspected and may be registered for either 12 or 24 months
- Military Police are updated daily on overdue temp and permanent plates
 - Citation will be issued
 - Plates will be removed from vehicle

YOUR VEHICLE MUST BE REGISTERED AT ALL TIMES! Operational or Non-Operational

Vehicle Registration Tips

1. Make an appointment: We offer our customers the ability to walk in anytime during operational hours but cannot always guarantee service. If you have an appointment, you are guaranteed to be seen and will have priority over walk-ins. You can schedule an appointment through the USAG Bavaria website from any smart device without needing a CAC card at the below link or using the QR code posted outside the office.

2. Come prepared and don't procrastinate your visit: There are checklists posted on the above page and outside the office for most situations to assist customers. Notifications for reregistration get sent to APOs within 75 days of expiration.

3. Email questions ahead of time: If you have a question about a special circumstance or are unsure about a process, email the Bavaria Vehicle Registration mailbox at the address below. The office is not staffed to answer calls or for a hotline.

4. Come early or return later: Our office opens at 0800 and daily operating hours are on the website. If the hallway is full and you don't have an appointment then we cannot guarantee you will receive timely service even if it's just to ask a question.





Vehicle Accidents



- If on post, immediately call the MP Station (DSN: 522-2812).
- If off post, report immediately to the German Polizei (Dial 110), and within 72hrs to the MP Station.



- Failure to report will result in being charged with either "Failure to report an accident" or "Fleeing the scene of an accident"
- This includes vehicle to animal collisions

 - > If you are responsible for refilling your oil tanks:
