SUAS/Drone Policy:

- The operation of any recreational SUAS on any USAG Bavaria installation is strictly **prohibited**; there are **no exceptions**



- SUAS refers to all systems that are operated remotely or with programmed GPS flight plans, including radio controlled (RC) aircraft, unmanned aerial vehicles, **drones** (all rotary and fixed winged), model airplanes, model helicopters, quadcopters, and balloons

- Personnel should immediately report any SUAS operated on or near a USAG Bavaria installation to the MP station

If you receive OHA and meet the following qualifications, you should participate in the survey:

- Assigned to Germany for at least 6 months
- Reside in Privately leased quarters (not a homeowner or *sharer)

Spouses are encouraged to complete the survey with the SM or if the SM is unavailable.

Survey participants should reference utility bills and recurring maintenance expense receipts or estimates in order to accurately complete the survey.



<p><u>Hohenfels Health Clinic</u></p> <p>Will monovalent Covid boosters be available, and will MMR vaccines be given to 6 month old infants?</p>	<p>Pfizer COVID Vaccine available at your local MTF in November 2023. This season's vaccine has been updated to provide better coverage against newer strains of COVID-19 to maximize protection. Eligible beneficiaries, including those eligible to receive vaccination services at an MTF may receive the vaccine. We will inform the community via our Facebook page when the vaccine is available. The CDC recommends MMR vaccination at the following ages: 2-dose series between 12 and 15 months and 4 and 6 years. Nevertheless, exceptional circumstances do arise in the context of international travel. Our providers at the Hohenfels Health Clinic adhere to the CDC's guidance attached. Our host nation counterparts follow a separate schedule, and the clinic can refer to a host nation provider to make an informed decision.</p>	<p>12 OCT 2023</p>
