IN-PROCESSING

- Registering all pets with the VTF within 14 days of arrival or acquisition or a pet is **REQUIRED** for all Active Duty regardless of intent to use services.
 - Contact the VTF for the required registration documents
 - Records from previous VTF's in the DoD system will transfer. Please bring all off-post vaccination records with registration paperwork, or email in **.pdf** format

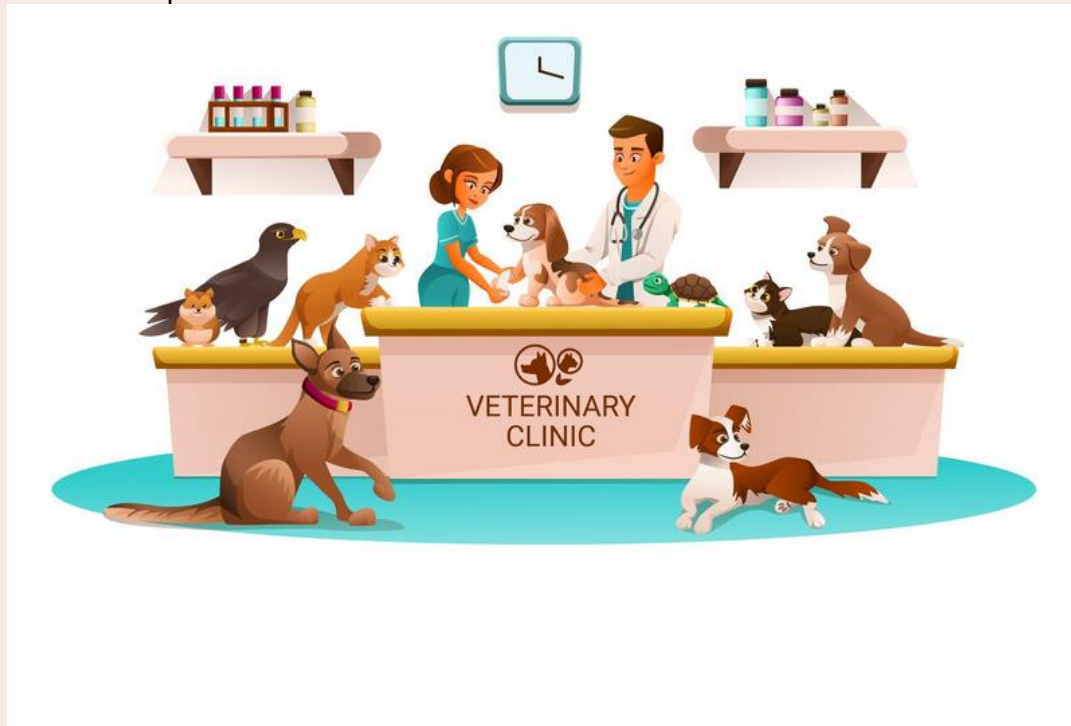
CLINIC HOURS:

SCHEDULING



- Our calendar opens up ONE month in advance
- On the 15th of each month, the next month becomes available (ex 15 October, November opens for scheduling, etc.) – This includes our surgical calendar
- If the 15th is a weekend or day we are closed, the next business day will be the opening of the schedule.
- If you call and cannot reach us, be sure to leave a voicemail with all contact information for us to call you back
- **We require 24 hour notice for all cancellations – No Show Policy**
 - 1ST NO Show – Warning
 - 2nd NO Show – Notice to command & 30 Day suspension
 - 3rd NO Show – Notice to command, 6 month suspension, only scheduled with NCOIC

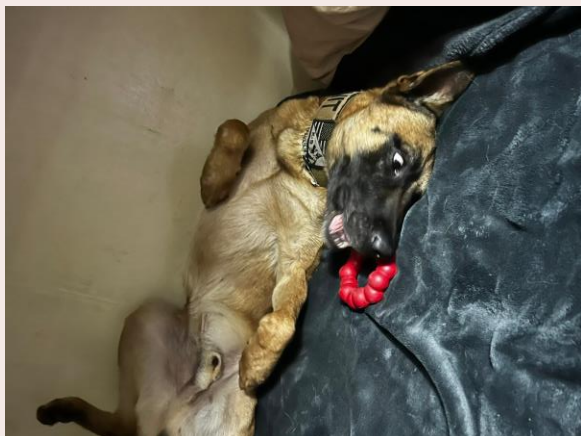

EU PET PASSPORTS

- If you plan on traveling outside of Germany while in the EU, an EU passport is required
- Must be obtained through any German (or EU Licensed) Veterinarian
- It is first and foremost ONLY a vaccine book
- Traveling without one risks being charged with illegal animal import
- Be sure to adhere to laws that apply to any countries you may visit



- No bark collars, prong collars, or shock collars.
- Training that utilizes pain as a method of training are not allowed

LAWS REGARDING DOG OWNERSHIP IN GERMANY

- When in the car, dogs must be secured in the back seat or fully kenneled in the back
- Dogs cannot be free roaming in the car, hanging out of the window, or in the front passenger seat/front passenger lap, etc.

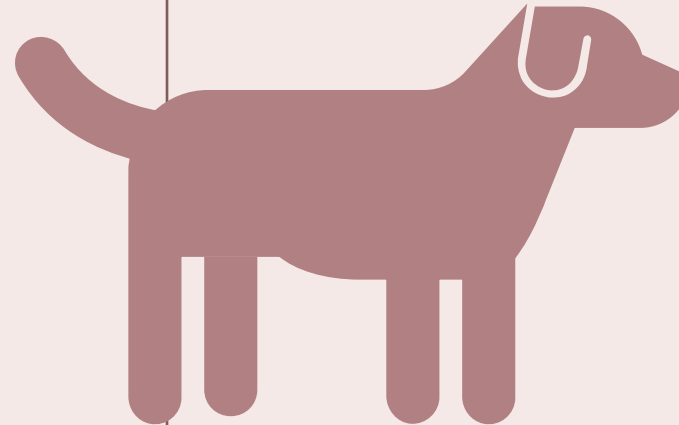

DoA Banned in all Army Housing/Lodging Including Army owned, privatized, and leased

THINKING OF ADOPTING A DOG WHILE HERE?

- Adoption here is far more difficult for our community. Why? Pet abandonment.
- Understand the needs of the dog breed that you are trying to find.
- Make sure you get an EU Pet Passport when adopting
- Breeding pets is FORBIDDEN in government housing and selling for large amounts may end up as German tax evasion
- Breeding pets will result in a suspension of all VTF services
- Remember age requirements for PCS!





WHEN THE TIME COMES TO PCS OUT...

- Inform the VTF if there is ANY chance you may be heading to another OCONUS location AS SOON AS POSSIBLE to avoid any complications
- DO NOT WAIT FOR ORDERS
- While OCONUS, always make sure that your pet is current on their rabies vaccine – it is better to be one month early than a single day late
- We will require a valid health certificate OR a MFR (provided by the VTF) signed by your commander stating that you have the appointment scheduled for their health certificate coming up OR orders showing that you are staying in Germany
- Why? Pet abandonment.
