### Vehicle registration Pilot program CONOP

#### 1) In-Processing

Customer in-processes with MPD and is identified as shipping a vehicle to VPC; receives brief (\*) and QR code on how to upload valid insurance documentation to Vehicle Registration Office

### 2) Upload Documents

VPC notifies customer of pending arrival of vehicle. Customer changes insurance from in-transit to active and uploads to VRO through received QR code. VRO validates insurance and sends roster to VPC.



Customer arrives at VPC with shipping documentation. VPC validates SM off roster from VRO and releases vehicle for inspection.

### 4) Vehicle Inspection

Customer takes vehicle and documentation directly to vehicle inspection.

#### 5A) PASS

Customer takes passed inspection to VRO, completes registration, and receives permanent plates. (1 appointment only with VRO)

#### 5B) <mark>FAIL</mark>

Customer must park vehicle and complete temporary plate appointment with VRO to correct deficiencies in order to receive permanent plates. (requires 2 appointments with VRO)



#### Control Measures:

- SM signs "Liability Statement of Understanding" memorandum explaining repercussions of not following process or departing without plates
- Validated list sent from VR to VPC along with automated email to communicate which vehicles are insured and cleared for release to SMs

- VR clerk validates correct documentation and dates & signs proof of insurance memo
- Automated message sent to both customer and VPC that customer is insured and is cleared to pickup vehicle for vehicle inspection within DTGs (e.g. between 17MAR-31MAR)
- Automation also ensures adequate time between VR, VPC, inspection, and final transaction to ensure all completed same day

#### 3) Vehicle Processing Center releases vehicle

### Are you and your children protected against measles?

With cases rising in Europe and nationally, it's crucial to check your MMR (measles-mumps-rubella) vaccine status. This vaccination is the most powerful tool in preventing measles.

U.S. ARMY

- **Children:** Two doses are recommended, the first at 12-15 months of age, and the second at 4-6 years of age.
- Adults: Adults who are not immune should receive at least one dose. Some adults may need two doses, especially those at higher risk (e.g., healthcare workers, international travelers).
- **Practice good hygiene:** While less effective than vaccination, practicing good hygiene, such as frequent handwashing, can help reduce the spread of many infections.

If you are unsure of your status, check with your healthcare provider to ensure you and your family are up-to-date on your vaccinations






