Topic		Notes
Vehicle Registration		Pilot program for new vehicle registration (17-28 March)
Childcare (DFMWR)		Extensive waitlist in the CDCs (all age groups) and only 5 for the School Age Center (4 of the 5 families have not arrived in country yet). Due to delay in funding approval for the FF&E for the TB CDC, bulk of the furniture expected to arrive in June. Due to the Hiring Freeze, the recruitment and on-boarding of critical staff for the TBCDC is extremely delayed. We project an opening of August 2025.
Driving Safety (Speeding)		Traffic Enforcement Plan in place, electric speed signage pending funding (Speed humps install starting Mid April 2025 followed by speed table install)
Out-processing Vehicle Inspection Standards	NEW	Inspection standards are identical across all Garrisons. AN VPC has higher capacity than TB VPC and ships fewer vehicles.






AVB install Information

Gate 6, Tower Barracks: from 5MAR - 07APR, both lanes coming onto main post will be closed for AVB replacement. If you want to access main post from Gate 6, you'll need to proceed to Gate 9 and enter from there.

Gate 4, HTA: from 15APR - 21MAY, expect delays due to AVB replacement. Both lanes will be completely closed and only open for foot traffic

Gate 6 HTA: 10APR - 20MAY, expect delays due to AVB replacement. Both lanes will be completely closed and only open for foot traffic

Vehicle Registration Update

- **DEVELOPING BUSINESS PLAN TO GENERATE ADDITIONAL REVENUE NEEDED TO MEET PERSONNEL REQUIREMENTS AT EACH VEH REG SITE**
- **ELIMINATE/REDUCE TEMPORARY LICENCES; PILOT AT ALL LOCATIONS WHERE VEH REG/PROCESSING/INSPECTIONS ARE COLOCATED AND IN A CONTROLLED AREA (GRAFENWOHR). 17-28MAR. TARGET POPULATION ARE THOSE UTILIZING VPC**
- **ENCOURAGE COMMUNITY TO REREGISTER VEHICLES THAT ARE DUE MAY-JUL TO REGISTER IN MAR-APR TO AVOID ANTICIPATED PCS CONGESTION. REREGISTER 75 DAYS PRIOR TO EXPIRATION**
- **WE ARE ALSO LOOKING TO REFINE/STREAMLINE PROCESSES TO INCLUDE REWRITING VEHICLE REGISTRATION REGULATION AND TO DEVELOP A STANDARDIZED QUEUING AND APPOINTMENT SYSTEM THAT MIRRORS THE AIR FORCE'S TWO-METER PROGRAM.**





Are you and your children protected against measles?


With cases rising in Europe and nationally, it's crucial to check your MMR (measles-mumps-rubella) vaccine status. This vaccination is the most powerful tool in preventing measles.

- **Children:** Two doses are recommended, the first at 12-15 months of age, and the second at 4-6 years of age.
- **Adults:** Adults who are not immune should receive at least one dose. Some adults may need two doses, especially those at higher risk (e.g., healthcare workers, international travelers).
- **Practice good hygiene:** While less effective than vaccination, practicing good hygiene, such as frequent handwashing, can help reduce the spread of many infections.

If you are unsure of your status, check with your healthcare provider to ensure you and your family are up-to-date on your vaccinations

What is the MMR Vaccine?

This is a safe and effective vaccine that is recommended to prevent 3 diseases.


