- **Gate Maintenance:** Gate maintenance will be conducted at Tower Barracks Gate 6 and Hohenfels Gate 4, starting Monday, Feb. 10 and will go through March 27. Please allow extra time for your commute, use alternate gates, and follow detour signs.
- **Commissary Update:** Grafenwoehr Commissary shoppers, the Commissary is currently working on a solution to repair their freezers. Please be aware that items like fresh beef, pork and chicken are available but may be located in different locations around the store. Also, if you have accidently taken home a Commissary shopping basket, please return it to the store.
- Recreational Drone Reminder: Recreational drones cannot be used on or around military installations. That includes U.S. Army installations, Navy bases, Air Force Bases, German Military Kaserne's, other government facilities (U.S. or otherwise) as well as no flight zones. - Value-Added Tax (VAT) App: Great news from Installation Management Command-Europe! Following the successful completion of a pilot program that began in March, IMCOM-Europe will transition to full implementation of the new micro-purchase Value-Added Tax (VAT) App program across Germany at the beginning of the year.
