# Daylight Running Lights and Driving in FOG Safety Tips



The Army has a saying, "everyone is a safety officer" and in the 405<sup>th</sup> AFSBn-Germany is no exception, this including our family members. We are in a country where language barriers limit our knowledge and understandings that may impact our daily lives. Recently, one of our family members overheard in a German radio station of an increased number of accidents due to Daylight Running Lights (DRLs). It stressed the importance of turning on headlights during commutes not DRLs.

DRLs, in some vehicles automatically switched on once the ignition is on; other vehicles may switch the DRLs on when the parking brake is released or when the vehicle is shifted into gear.

DRLs can be *hazardous*, when driving at night or during foggy conditions a driver may thinks his headlights are on when they are not. Here's why:

- 1. Generally, DRLs do not shine as brightly as do headlights. A driver may needlessly struggle to see, blaming the poor headlights, when in fact the headlights aren't even on he is using only the (reduced) light from the DRLs.
- 2. Another reason, DRLs do not illuminate the rear taillights at all...but the driver doesn't know the taillights are off! This can be quite a surprise for a driver approaching from behind especially in foggy conditions.

This design in some vehicles (we tested several different models in our parking lot) may be different in your vehicle. The test showed that when the daylight running lights was on, the front was illuminated for the road ahead, but the taillights were off.

When operating unfamiliar vehicles i.e. TMP, leased vehicle, or rental car, or friend's car, become familiar with that vehicle DRLs and Fog lights operations.





Fog creates dangerous driving conditions. It reduces visibility, makes it hard to spot hazards, and it becomes difficult for a driver to judge distance. The unusual weather condition can create optical illusions. Drivers may misjudge their own speed or have a hard time determining if other cars are moving.

The best advise for driving in fog is not to. If you must drive, be sure to consider the following:

- 1. Slowdown before you enter the fog. Do not assume that the fog will thin out after entering it.
- 2. Use low beams not DRLs, this will increase your visibility and help other drivers see you. Turning on your high beams will make the fog reflect more light at a higher angle creating a white out effect.
- 3. Minimize distractions While always important, minimizing distractions is more critical in foggy weather.
- 4. Obey all fog-related warning signs.
- 5. Navigate with reflectors use reflectors on the road or the right edge to ensure you are staying in your lane. This works also with sun glare.
- 6. Increase following distance Use the 3 second rule all the time and increase that to five during inclement weather like fog.
- 7. Reduce speed reducing your speed will give you more time to react.
- 8. Listen to traffic you cannot see and avoid passing other vehicles.
- 9. Be cautious of other drivers that may have forgotten to turn on their headlights.



LITHIUM-ION BATTERIES store a lot of energy in a small place. These batteries can overheat, start a fire, or explode if overcharged or damaged. By learning how to **BUY**, **CHARGE**, and **RECYCLE** these batteries safely, you can help prevent a fire in your home.



**BUY** only listed products. When buying a product that uses a lithium-ion battery look for a safety certification mark such as UL, ETL, or CSA. This means it meets important safety standards.



**STOP** using your device right away if the battery smells weird, gets too hot, makes popping noises, changes in shape or color. If it is safe, move the device away from anything that can catch fire. Call **9-1-1**.



**CHARGE** devices safely. Always use the cables that came with the product to charge. Follow the instructions from the manufacturer. Buy new chargers from the manufacturer or one that the manufacturer has approved.



**RECYCLE** batteries responsibly. Don't throw lithium-ion batteries in the trash or regular recycling bins because they could start a fire.



**CHARGE** your device on a hard surface. Don't overcharge your device. Unplug it or remove the battery when it's fully charged.



**RECYCLE** your device or battery at a safe battery recycling location. Visit **call2recycle.org** to find a recycling spot near you.




