> Trick-or-Treat hrs. 1700-1900 hrs.

Stay Visible

- Wear light-colored or reflective clothing so you are easily seen by drivers.
- Stay within well-lit areas and use a flashlight.
- Make safe costume choices ensure children's costumes allow them to see and move freely.

[2] Be Aware

- Drivers: Drive with extreme caution, especially in neighborhoods and near event areas.
- Trick-or-Treaters: Cross only at corners or designated crosswalks. Always look both ways before crossing and never dart out from between parked cars.

3 Check Your Treats

- · Only visit homes with their lights on, as this indicates they are participating.
- Never enter a stranger's home or vehicle.
- Do not eat any treats until you are home and an adult has inspected them.
- · Children under 12 should always be accompanied by a trusted adult.



Winter?!

The general rule of "von O bis O" (from O to O) for installing winter tires, means snow tires should be put on in October and remain on until Ostern (Easter). German law requires that vehicles have "adequate tires" for winter driving.

- Winter tires must be marked with the Alpine-Symbol (a 3-peak mountain with a snowflake in the center).
- All-season tires or winter tires marked with M+S that are produced prior to 2018, **no** longer approved as of Sept. 30, 2024.
- The law also apply to motorbikes, trucks snowflake) and buses, regardless of whether the driver is the owner or is renting the vehicle. All of these vehicles must be equipped with winter tires if you drive in snow or icy conditions.
- Having an accident without winter tires will result in a fine of 60 to 100 euros. Insurance companies may not pay for damages caused by the accident
- German Police also conduct safety checks from time to time, if caught without the proper winter tires could also result in an on-thespot fine of 60 to 100 euros.

Winter Road Conditions in USAG Bavaria

Personnel must understand and adhere to the Garrison's winter road conditions policy, as outlined in USAREUR Regulation 385-55. A key component of this policy is the **Road Condition Status**, which is communicated through a color-coded system:

•Green: All-clear. Roads are clear, and you can proceed with normal driving.

•Amber: Drive with caution. Expect poor road conditions and allow for extra travel time.

•Red: All non-mission-essential travel is prohibited. Expect significant road hazards and possible closures.

Public Works 3rd Party Housing Inspections



- Who: 100% of all Family housing on Army installations
- What: Congress has mandated that 100% of all Family housing on Army installations will be inspected by an independent, third-party contractor retained by the Department of the Army.
- · When: Inspection Windows are:
 - USAG Bavaria (Garmisch): 22-23 January 2026
 - USAG Bavaria (Hohenfels, On Post): 26-30 January 2026
 - USAG Bavaria (Tower Barracks/Rose Barracks, On Post): 2-12 February 2026
 - USAG Bavaria (Tower Barracks/Rose Barracks, Off Post): 24 February 13 March 2026
 - USAG Bavaria (Hohenfels, Off Post): 9-13 March 2026
- Where: Inspections include the entire perimeter and interior rooms of homes.
- Why: To ensure the Army's housing assets are safe and habitable.
- <u>How:</u>
- Residents will be required to schedule inspection appointments using a web-based QR code
- The scheduling tool will open 5-6 weeks before inspections begin
- Further instructions will be provided through social media and banners through the

garrison

FALL CLEAN UP 2025

BULKY ITEMS PICK UP ON POST – TOWER BARRACKS

WHEN AND WHERE?

- Thursday, 6 NOV 2025 -

On-post Housing Areas and Troop Billeting Areas

at the Recycling points at the stairwell houses and barracks, pick up location is curb side for housing areas

Bulk Trash has to be set out NLT 6 a.m on pick up day but not earlier than 1 day before pick up day.

Pick up is performed in three steps. Please stack separately: Combustible Material (upholstered furniture, mattresses, rugs etc.), Electronic equipment (vacuum cleaners, TVs, printer, Refrigerators, freezers etc.), Salvageable wooden furniture (bed frames, wardrobes, chairs, tables etc.)

WHAT WILL BE PICKED UP?

wooden furniture, upholstered furniture, plastic furniture, metal furniture, mattresses, carpets, rugs, bicycles, strollers, vacuum cleaners, duvets, stoves, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, dryers, dish washers, outdoor furniture, printers, TVs, computers, stereo systems, rain barrels, coffee makers Refrigerators and freezers must be handled and placed with care so that the cooling coils will not get damaged.

Leafs should be placed in paper-bags (available at Self Help Store Bldg. 394) at the Bulk Trash pick up points.

WHAT WILL NOT BE PICKED UP?

And where to get rid of it

FALL CLEAN UP 2025

BULKY ITEMS PICK UP ON POST – ROSE BARRACKS

WHEN AND WHERE?

- THURSDAY, 6 NOV 2025 -

On-post Housing Areas and Troop Billeting Areas at designated locations (signs posted)

Bulk Trash has to be set out NLT 6 a.m. on pick up day but not earlier than 1 day before pick up day.

Please stack separately

- Pick ups will be performed in three steps: 1. All electric & metal items /like TVs, washers, dryers, bicycles, etc.
 - 2. All other material /like mattresses, carpets, furniture, etc.
 - 3. Leaves should be placed in a pile near the curb or placed in CLEAR trash bags so that the workers can see that leaves are in the bag and not refuse. The leaves on the curbside will be vacuumed up by a big "Vac Truck".

WHAT WILL BE PICKED UP?

Items, that are too large or too heavy to fit into a normal car's trunk, like the following:

Furniture, mattresses, carpets, washing machines, dryers, refrigerators, freezers, large TVs, ovens, stoves, bicycles, etc., and other items that cannot be dismantled, torn or broken down to a size that would fit. Refrigerators and freezers must be handled and placed with care so that the cooling coils will not get damaged.

WHAT WILL NOT BE PICKED UP?

And where to get rid of it

Normal refuse and recyclable material (cardboard, paper, cans, glass, plastics, etc.) individual bins – excess please take to Recycling Center (Bldg. 107)

Garden refuse like cut grass, branches, bush trimmings, plants, etc.

"Green Waste" Collection Point across Self Help Store (Bldg. 103)

Hazardous waste like batteries, oil, antifreeze, paint, cleaners, solvents, etc. DPW Self Help Store (Bldg. 103)

Wrecked cars, car parts, motorcycles, engine parts, etc.

Auto Craft Shop (Bldg. 711)

Tires

Recycling Center (Bldg. 107)

Note: Bulky items or any other excess trash can always be brought to the Recycling Center, on Wilbur Road, next to the CIF (Bldg. 102),




