Positive Progress Made Since Last Town Hall

- ✓ Lawn care services are underway
 - ✓ Edging and mulching of beds
 - ✓ Mowing every 7-10 days
 - ✓ Pre-emergent herbicide application

 - ✓ Crosswalk and curb painting
 - ✓ Repair and painting of mail kiosks
 - ✓ Power washing of homes
- ✓ Woodlawn community garden plots reopened
- ✓ Preventative maintenance inspections of HVAC system in Q2 underway with air filter changes performed in all homes during Q1 and will be again in Q3 and Q4
- ✓ Cordless blinds being installed in all homes
- ✓ Chimney inspections and cleaning for wood burning fireplaces underway.






Positive Progress – McRee Barracks Renovations

Positive Progress Made Since Last Town Hall

- ✓ Provide private bedrooms with bathroom and common living areas including kitchens with enhanced cooking capabilities.
- ✓ Project will correct life, health safety deficiencies and improve Heating, Air Conditioning and hot water delivery.
- ✓ Bldgs. 2102, 2103, 2109 & 2110 are 82% complete with an estimated completion date of AUG 2022.
- ✓ Bldgs. 2104 & 2111 are in the process of relocating existing personnel to allow renovations to commence. Estimated completion APR 2022.
- ✓ Army is investing roughly \$60M to improve the living conditions for Junior Enlisted SMs assigned to Fort Belvoir.







Housing Update – Bulk Trash Pick Up Options

Bulk Trash Pick Up Options for Residents

Guidelines and schedule for residents to have bulk trash items picked-up by the Villages waste management provider, American Disposal Services.

- American Disposal is able to pick up three (3) items per household/visit.
- Bulk trash pickup occurs on Mondays.
- Residents are asked to schedule a pick-up ahead of time through your Community Management Office and be certain to submit your request no later than **Thursday by 5:00 PM** for pickup on the following Monday.
- Once a pick-up is scheduled, bulk trash items would need to be placed out with regular trash by Monday at 5:00 AM.

Residents with questions are asked to please reach out to their Community Management Office for assistance.



BULK TRASH PICK-UP

HOW TO DISPOSE OF OVERSIZED ITEMS

Simply follow these steps to schedule your pick-up:

- American Disposal is able to pick up three (3) items per household/visit.
- Bulk trash pickup occurs on Mondays.
- Please schedule a pick-up ahead of time through your Community Management Office and be certain to submit your request no later than Thursday by 5:00 PM for pickup on the following Monday.
- Once you have scheduled a pickup, please place your bulk trash items out with your regular trash on Monday by 5:00 AM.

You may also drop off bulk trash items in the dumpsters located in the rear of our Maintenance Building located at 603416th Street, Building 1108, Hours: Monday - Friday | 8AM - 5PM,

There are items that American Disposal cannot pick-up. These include washers, dryers and exercise equipment such as treadmills and ellipticals. For your convenience, Villages at Belvoir staff is available to pick these items up for a fee of \$25 per item.




Housing Update – Online Resident Portal

Directorate of Public Works – Dumping Update

Illegal dumping has become a real problem on Fort Belvoir.

Directorate of Public Works – Potholes @ Hospital

The potholes at the Hospital are being worked.

Temporary steel plates have been installed in each location.

A permanent solution is being contracted now, and should start soon.









Directorate of Public Works – Dogue Creek Bridge

Construction is expected to start soon, and will complete towards the end of the calendar year.

Demolition is scheduled to begin at the end of June.

Construction is expected to go through the end of November, possibly into December.







Directorate of Public Works – Off Limits Locations

Certain areas are off limits to unauthorized personnel. This is for your safety and to protect environmental quality.

Do not enter:

Environmentally Sensitive Areas

- Includes most wooded areas on the installation (even around housing)
- Areas include dangerous terrain, important cultural resources, wetlands, and protected habitat and species

Stormwater Management Facilities

- Look like ponds or land depressions when dry
- Fill quickly during storms and collect pollutants
- Must remain in good working order to prevent dangerous flooding on the garrison
- Very expensive to repair

Poe Road

A portion of Poe Road acts as the McCarty Connector Trail. The remainder of Poe Road is a restricted area.






COVID Vaccine Update

- Food and Drug Administration has approved EMERGENCY USE of the Pfizer BioNTech vaccine in adolescents age 12-15 years old.
- Awaiting guidance from DoD and Defense Health Agency on eligibility for this age bracket.
- COVID Vaccine Clinic has expanded hours, by appointment, 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. daily, with walk-ins welcome from 3 – 5 p.m. (subject to vaccine availability)
