Positive Progress – Housing Initiatives

Positive Progress Made Since Last Town Hall

- ✓ New Hires
- Housing Ombudsman
- Industrial Health Specialist Safety Office
- ✓ Mayor Program
- 15 Mayors/Deputy Positions
- ✓ Playground Repairs & Re-openings
- Safety Concerns identified and assessed
- ➤ Plan to repair & re-open 38 playgrounds
- Roughly half have already been addressed and re-opened.
- Remaining playgrounds to be re-opened at two per week until complete.
- ✓ The Villages has a dedicated Liaison for displaced Residents.






Positive Progress – McRee Barracks Renovations

Positive Progress Made Since Last Town Hall

- ✓ Provide private bedrooms with bathroom and common living areas including kitchens with enhanced cooking capabilities.
- Project will correct life, health safety deficiencies and improve Heating, Air Conditioning and hot water delivery.
- Bldgs. 2102, 2103, 2109 & 2110 are 67% complete with an estimated completion date of AUG 2022.
- Bldgs. 2104 & 2111 are in the process of relocating existing personnel to allow renovations to commence. Estimated completion APR 2022.
- ✓ Army is investing roughly \$60M to improve the living conditions for Junior Enlisted SMs assigned to Fort Belvoir.







Positive Progress – Housing Initiatives

Positive Progress Made Since Last Town Hall

✓ Launched Initiatives to Address Three Major Concerns

Mold in Ductwork

- ✓ Inspect remaining 38 of 607 units with fibrous duct board.
- ✓ Army SMEs and Project Environmental Consultants to align standards.
- ✓ Conduct Pilot Project to replace duct board by 31 DEC 2020.
- ✓ Hire HVAC Contractor to perform Preventative Maintenance in all units during 2021.

Water Intrusion

- √ 100% Inspection of units with basements by 29 JAN 2021.
- ✓ Install early leak detection systems in all Gerber and Belvoir Village homes 31 DEC 2020.
- Install rain gutter downspout extensions 31 DEC 2020.
- ✓ Perform gutter cleaning each year DEC through MAR.

Electrical Safety Concerns

- ✓ Hire a Master Electrician by 31 DEC 2020.
- ✓ Inspect 59 homes with reported concerns by 15 DEC 2020.
- ✓ Inspect 25% of all units by 31 DEC 2021.







Installation Access

Fort Belvoir Traffic

- ✓ Increased Security and HPCON Posture. Allow additional time at gates.
- ✓ J.J. Kingman ACP will temporarily close for critical repairs 30 Nov thru 20 Dec 20. Lieber Gate will be opened from 0600-1800hrs daily until the repairs have been completed.
- ✓ Be prepared to show valid identification and be prepared to be searched before entering the installation.
- ✓ Valid ID: DoD Common Access Card; military retiree ID; DoD family member ID; or Fort Belvoir visitor pass.
- ✓ Travelers and passengers without a valid ID card listed above must go to the Visitor Center at Tully Gate, weekdays, 0600 -1800hrs to get a visitor's pass. After hours vetting will be completed at Tulley Gate (Commercial /Visitor Lane).
- ✓ Visitors can also apply on-line for and **Expedited Visitor Pass**. Go to the Fort Belvoir Website for further information.
- ✓ All visitors, 16 and older, must have a valid driver's license, state ID card, or U.S. passport to get a Belvoir visitor pass.

Note: Expired DoD Common Access Cards will be accepted for access until 30 Jun 21.
