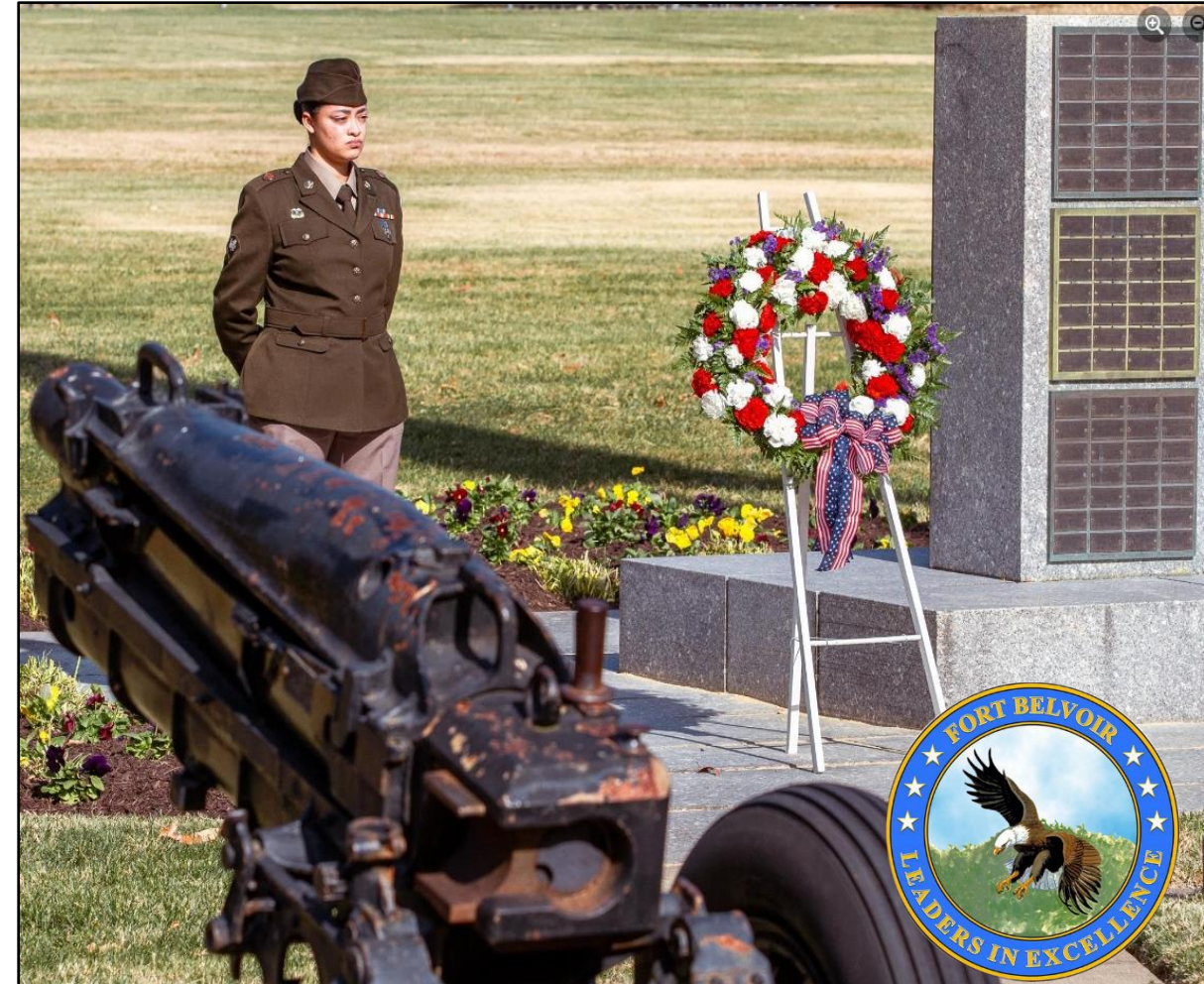
Veterans Day Celebration

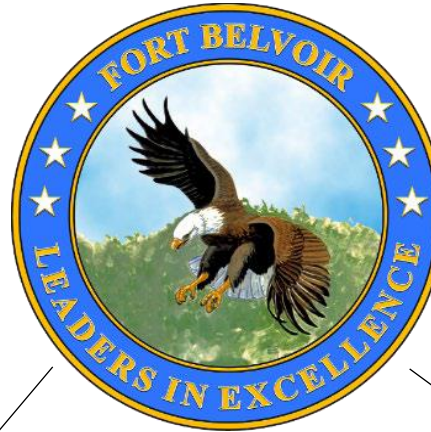

Barracks Update

- Soldiers - **do *not* flush any foreign matter** down the toilets other than toilet paper. We have had several sewage backups attributed to Soldiers flushing shop rags and other objects
- **"Flushable wipes" are *not* flushable** so please do not flush them. They are not designed to disintegrate in pipes like toilet paper and can cause dangerous problems. Just don't use them

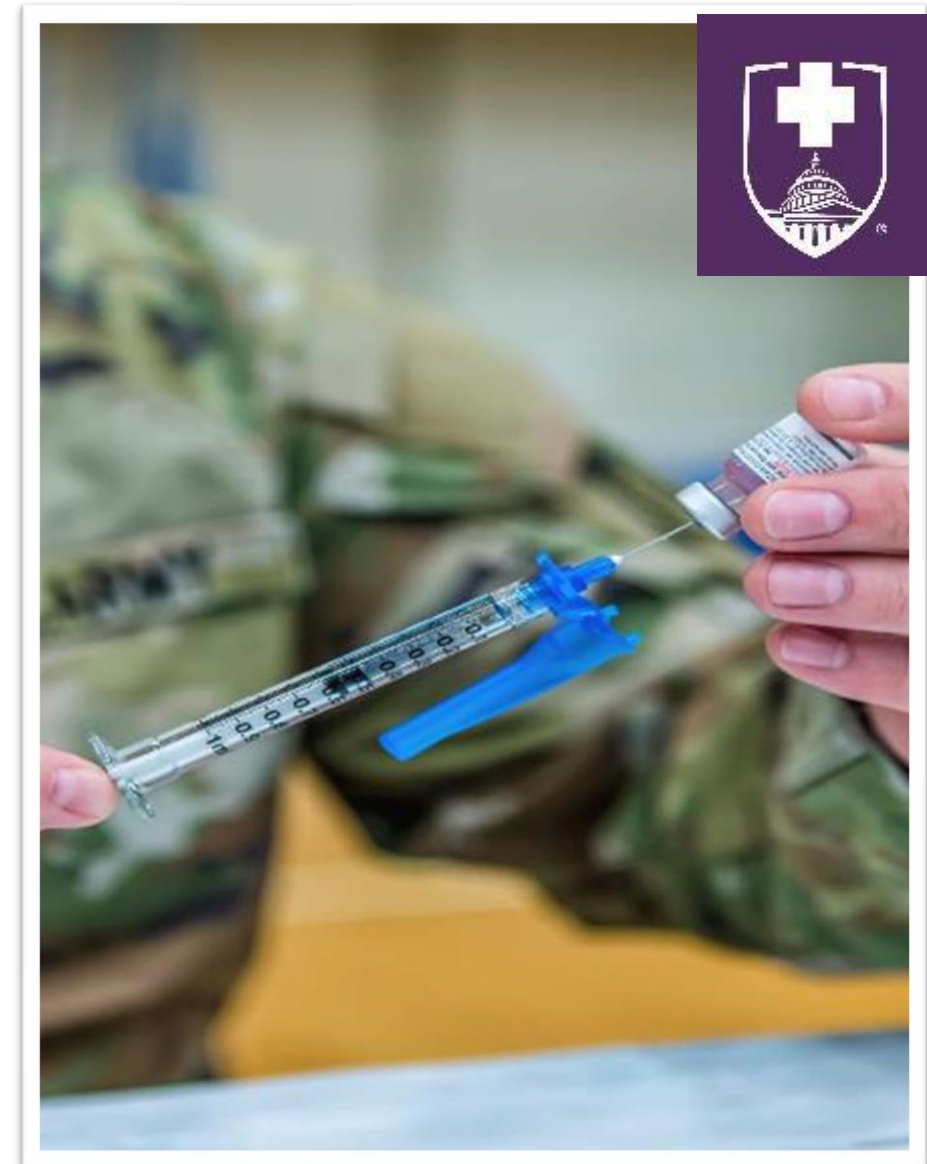

Rental Partnership Program (RPP)



RENTAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (RPP)

The program provides quality affordable off-post housing for permanent party military personnel stationed at Fort Belvoir.

Eligibility Requirements

- Active duty service member must be eligible to receive Basic Allowance of Housing (BAH) and the rental amount must be equal to or less than the BAH.
- Active duty service members are required to enter into a lease commitment of a minimum of 6 or 12 months duration.
- Rental payments are facilitated through payroll allotment, either via "My Pay" (<https://mypay.dfas.mil>), or by arranging allotment setup at a Finance office (<https://www.military.com/base-guide/fort-belvoir/contact/finance-office/2634>).

Rental Benefits

- 5% discount on monthly rent
- Application fees waived
- Income requirements waived
- Credit check fees waived
- Security deposit waived

Ongoing Housing Projects

- **2024 Ongoing projects:**
 - **Installation of Window Safety Locks on all homes.**
 - All homes will have window safety locks installed in compliance with Evan's Law in 2024
 - The windowsill is 72" or more above grade from the exterior of the home.
 - Project expected to be completed by the end of the year
 - **New Electronic Lock Pilot**
 - Pilot was kicked off in October in hospitality suites
 - Plan to implement after the holidays
 - **New Air Filter Pilot**
 - New filters can be cleaned versus tossing out reducing our carbon footprint and more convenient for residents.
 - **Basement Water Proofing**
 - Addressing open work orders as a priority
 - All homes will be addressed as part of the project

Mold: Causes and Preventions

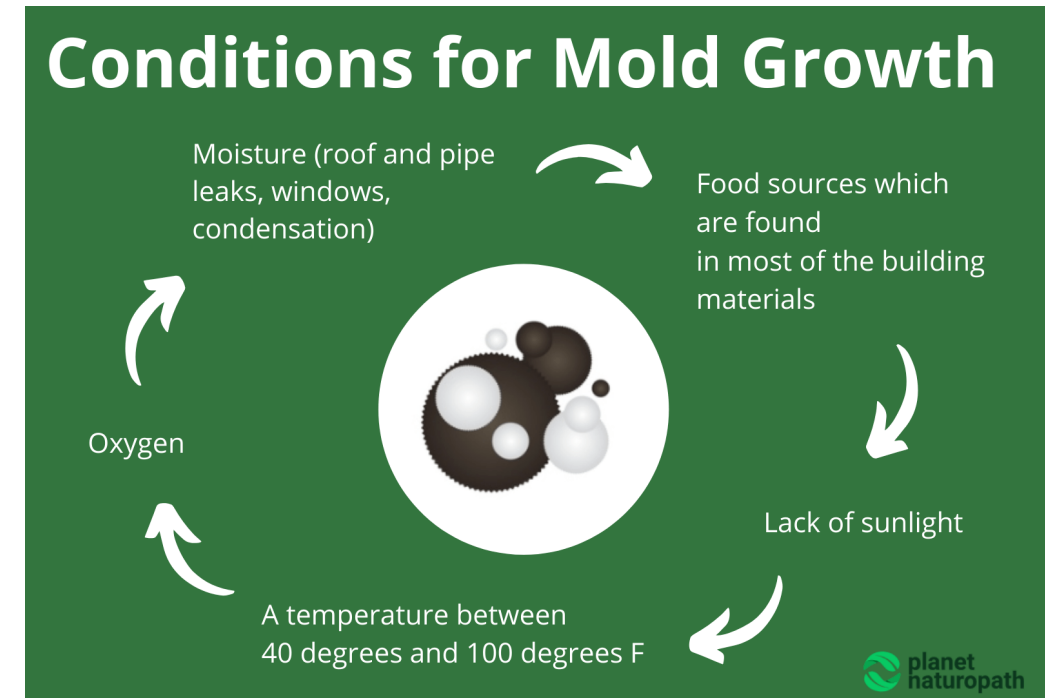
IMCOM Operation Counter Mold: US Army's plan to establish a battle rhythm to counter mold through **prevention**, **education** and **mitigation**.

Mold Basics:

- Mold is naturally occurring—it's everywhere
- It can grow almost anywhere
- It needs moisture, oxygen, and a nutrition source

Visible mold should be removed from living areas

- Signifies unwanted water intrusion, excess moisture, or excess humidity





Garrison Safety Update

Mold Prevention, Continued

- Inspect your house
 - Downspouts/drains - **especially with summer here**
 - Bathroom vents, vents around house - vacuum if necessary
 - Roof shingles missing
- Inspect your workplace
 - Know your facility manager
 - Know your USO
- Be observant, investigate and report asap
 - Water leaks or drips - act fast to stop the leak
 - Water stains
 - New “musty, mildewy” smells

Prevent the 911 call

- Check Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarms- *You May Save a Life Tonight*
- Check Dryer Vents
- Reduce clutter / Prevent heavy fire load conditions & Egress concerns
- Familiarize yourself with your house / building layouts (kitchen location, stairwells, floors, construction, number of bedrooms, occupancy loading, etc.) and the other tenants.
- **Exit Drills In The Home** (EDITH)-Have a plan and practice it!
- Check Fire Extinguishers—Learn to Pull Aim Squeeze Sweep (PASS)
- Note any “Safety In Our Community” Concerns

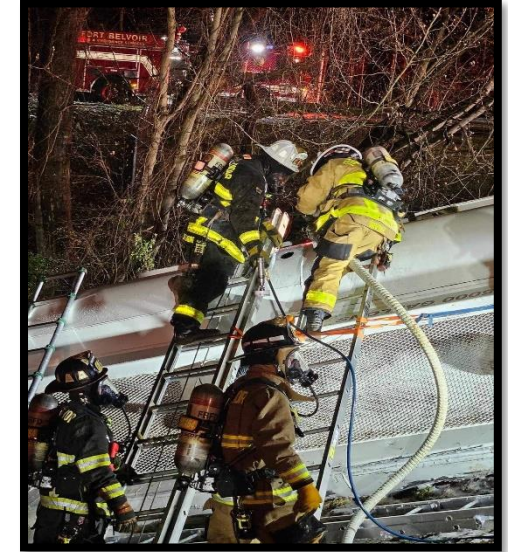

Community Concerns

- **Gates** remain a challenge with just 70% staffing of Security Guards, but hires continue. It will be a while before we can extend hours or staffing another gate
- **Housing Issues** need to go through established process: submit work order, escalate to mayor, then to Ombudsman
- **PCS Access** is seen as you escorting the movers to/from the house and signing them in at the gate after they've been vetted; you **are not** their sponsors
- **Speeding** continues to be reported across the installation, but data shows it is a small number of repeat speeders. Belvoir Police has roaming patrols to detect/discourage speeders
