(1) DEBRIS COLLECTION SITE: Located on South Post on the opposite side of the street from the Fort Belvoir Thrift Shop on 21st Street.

### **AUTHORIZED WASTE:**

**Concrete, Unusable Household Furniture, Construction and Demolition Materials, Scrap Wood, Tires, Scrap Metals.**

### **UNAUTHORIZED WASTE:**

**Liquids, Hazardous Wastes, Regulated Medical Wastes, Household Waste (goes to BLDG. 1108), Fluorescent Lamps, Refrigerant Containers, White Goods Containing Refrigerant, Broken Lead Acid Batteries, Dead Animals, Items from Off Post, Ballasts, Cylinders.**

(2) RECYCLING CENTER: Building 1089, across from the Class 6 Burger King/gas station located on South Post. It's physical address is 1089 Pohick Road

**AUTHORIZED ITEMS: Cardboard, Newspaper, Mixed Paper, Computer Paper, White Paper, Aluminum and Bi-metal cans Glass, all types of Plastics, Batteries, Used Motor oil, Toner Cartridges.**

(3) Compost Yard: Located behind the Recycling Center at 1089 Pohick Road.

**AUTHORIZED ITEMS: Grass Clippings, Leaves, Wood Chips (NOT mixed with trash/waste items).**
