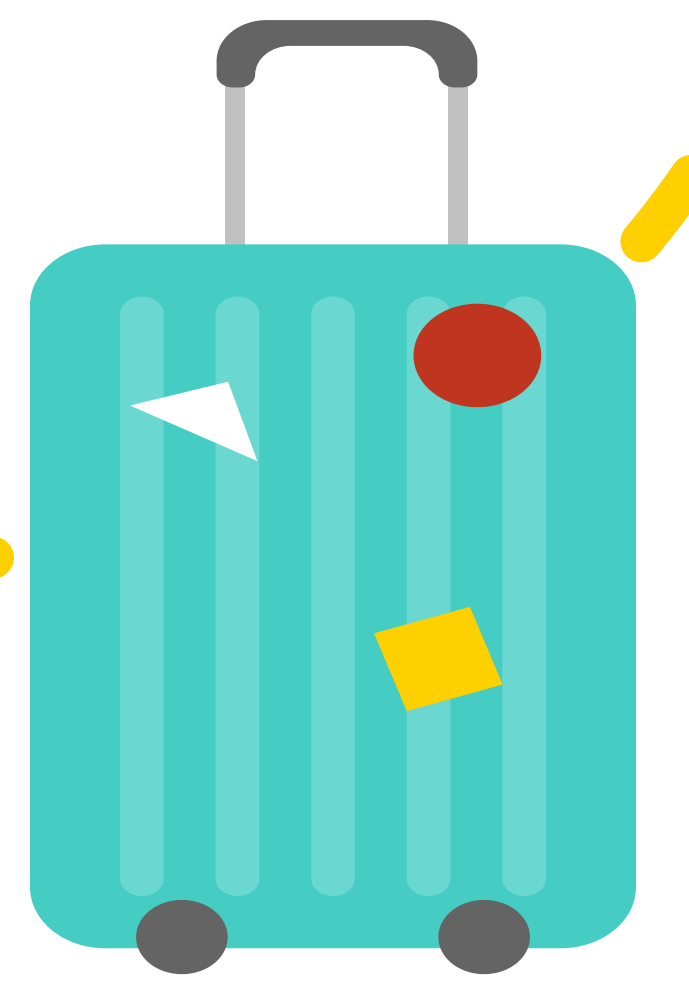


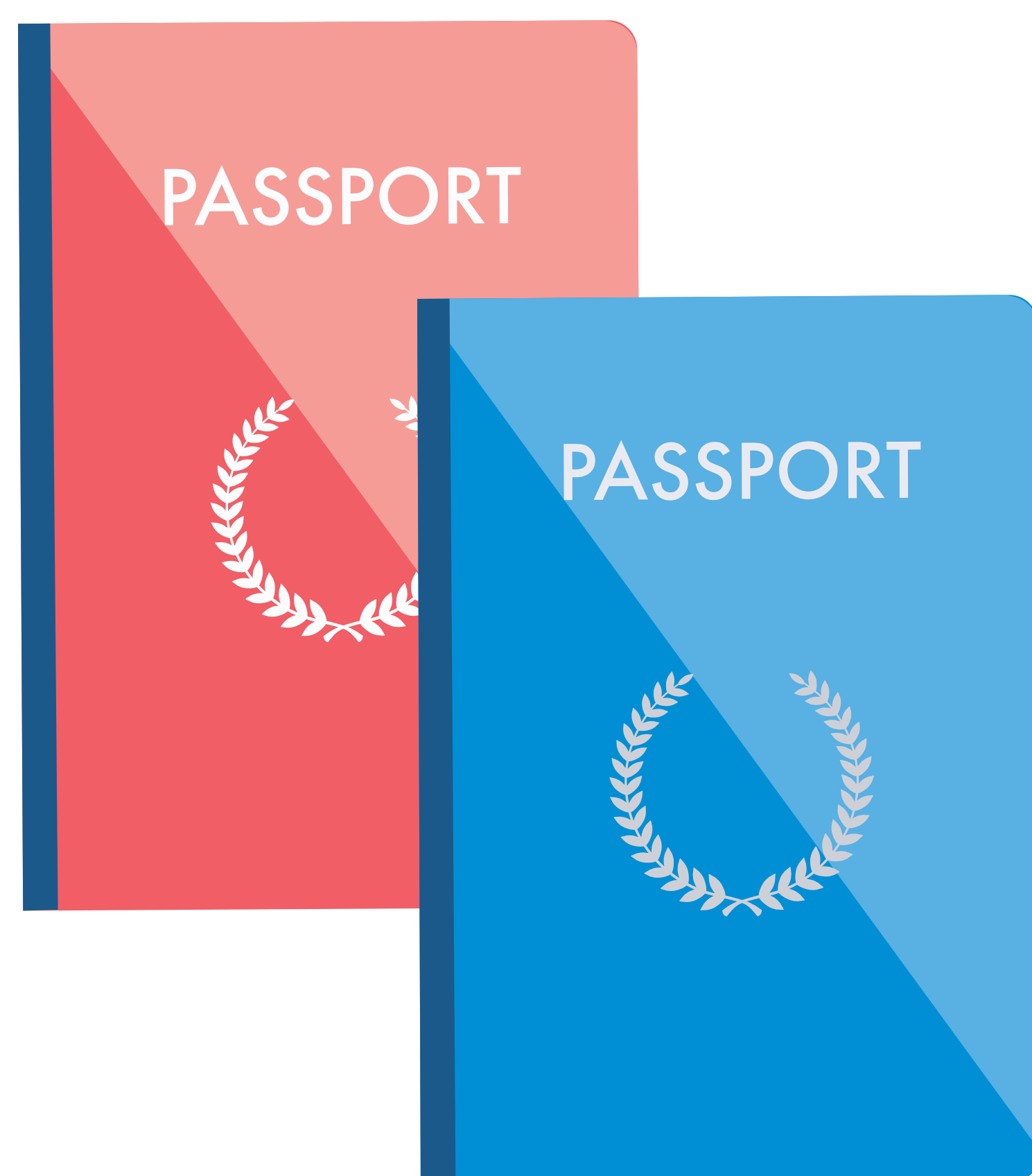


U.S. Army Europe Procedures for Unofficial Travel During COVID-19



As of Sept. 1, 2020

1 - Country Requirements



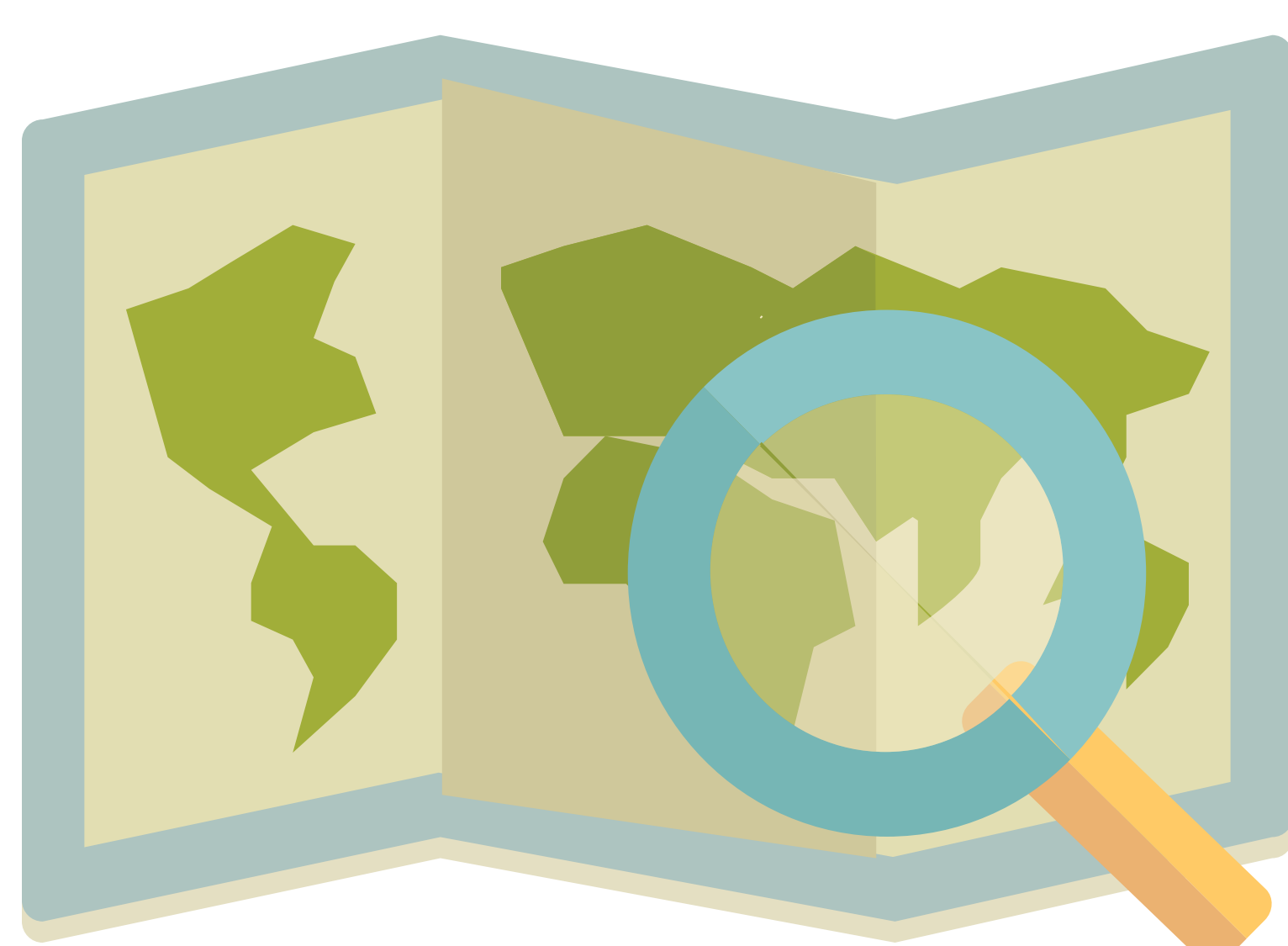
- ✓ Before you travel, visit the State Departments' COVID-19 Country Specific Information page at: <https://go.usa.gov/xG4C8>
- ✓ If the State Department recommends you don't travel to a location that is U.S. Army Europe's recommendation as well.
- ✓ If you do travel, be sure to check <https://reopen.europa.eu/en> to determine the re-entry requirements of your host nation. Be prepared to quarantine with any travel and support yourself if stuck in the visiting country for an extended period of time.

2 - Unit Requirements



- ✓ Visit www.eur.army.mil/Coronavirus to find links to local/commander's requirements based on the Senior Responsible Officer for your area.
- ✓ Advise your supervisor of any travel by you and your dependents. Travel by those in the same household may result in quarantine for the sponsor based on your supervisor's discretion.

3 - Other Considerations



- ✓ Check the websites often - especially while traveling - the info changes daily. If a country becomes more restricted or re-entry becomes an issue, contact your supervisor for further guidance.
- ✓ Each organization has unique requirements and may localize this guidance to be more restrictive.
- ✓ Despite what you may have seen online, there is no U.S. Army Europe map outlining unofficial travel restrictions.
