Carnaval or Fashing is an important local tradition in the southern part of the Netherlands celebrated this year February 23-

25. Shops in Limburg and parts of Germany will close while pubs and bars will stay open until at least 3 a.m. The streets will overflow with Carnaval revelers and parades. If held up by a parade, don't try to cut through the revelry. It could cause a serious accident and it shows a lack of respect for host nation cultural events. Due to recent incidents be careful and remain vigilant when in a large crowd or gathering.

If a parade is in progress, park the car and enjoy the festivities. But remember to be safe and don't drink and drive!

Sittard has a Carnaval brass band contest on Monday, **February 24**, 3 p.m. at the Market Square. On Tuesday, **February 25**, 2:11 p.m., groups of costumed people give out oranges to kids and adults who yell: "APPELSIENE, APPELSIENE" (oranges, oranges).

Aachen, Cologne, Düsseldorf and other large cities in Germany stage parades, called "Rosenmontag Zug", Monday, **February 24**. They all start around noon. **Aachen** also has a Children's parade Sunday, **February 23**.

Maaseik in Belgium has a clowns' Parade in the center of town on Tuesday, **February 25**. The event starts at 8:11 p.m.
