MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Command Policy 2022-002 – Photography Prohibition on Mihail Kogalniceanu Air Base (MKAB), Romania and Novo Selo Training Area (NSTA), Bulgaria.

1. In accordance with 18 U.S. Code § 795, it is unlawful to make any photograph, sketch, picture, drawing, map or graphical representation of military installations or equipment without first obtaining prior authorization from the Installation Commander.
2. To obtain authorization, personnel must submit their written request to the Army Support Activity-Black Sea (ASA-BS) Physical Security Office (PSO). The request will list the individuals and the event to be photographed. If approved, individuals shall be permitted to photograph or video only the requested function in the request area. Individuals must present the authorization letter when asked to ensure compliance with the parameters under which authorization was granted.
3. Unless specifically stated, does not grant post-wide authorization. Personnel found taking photos or video without proper authorization are subject to have their device confiscated and forwarded to the Counterintelligence Black Sea Field Office for examination and removal of photos and videos to ensure operational security. Any U.S. person that takes unauthorized photography and/or video may be charged under Uniform Code of Military Justice or 18 USC as applicable. The Garrison Commander may bar U.S. personnel and contractors operating under U.S. contracts from post. Third country nationals, including contractors, that take unauthorized photography and/or video may be charged under Romanian law.
4. Exceptions. Military Police and Counterintelligence personnel performing official duties do not require the waiver.
