




Once on the website: Select "I Accept"






- 1) Select "West" in the Region drop down menu.

Intermediate Driver Training

□Per AR 385-10, Intermediate Driver Training is a 2.5-hour course that is required for all Army personnel as part of the Army Traffic Safety Training Program. New Service Members on Fort Bliss under 26 years of age who have
not had the training is required to take the training.
