WHAT IS BSEP?

Basic Skills Enrollment Program (BSEP) is an on-duty education program designed to improve your GT score that provides academic instruction to support Soldier's job-related learning, performance of military duties, career progression, and lifelong learning.

HOW DO I ENROLL?

- ☐ **STEP 1:** Send a message through ArmyIgnitED set subject as BSEP

 - **Civilians must contact us at 915-568-6831**
- ☐ **STEP 2:** Receive IMCOM 43 Form and 4187 Form for commander signature; complete and return.
- ☐ **STEP 3:** Receive BSEP enrollment confirmation via ArmyIgnitED with classroom details.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW WHEN I AM ENROLLED?

- ☐ Class is held Monday-Thursday. Fridays are tutoring days or instructor makeup classes. Hours are 0900-1200 or 1300-1600. No classes are scheduled during federal holidays.
- ☐ Attendance is mandatory. Only 3 excused or unexcused absences are allowed. If you miss the first day, you will be dropped from the course. Your commander will be informed of absences.
- ☐ Once you take the AFCT, the results will be your new line scores regardless if you increased or decreased. You must wait 6 months before you can retake the AFCT.
- ☐ The class will focus on word knowledge, paragraph comprehension, and arithmetic reasoning.
