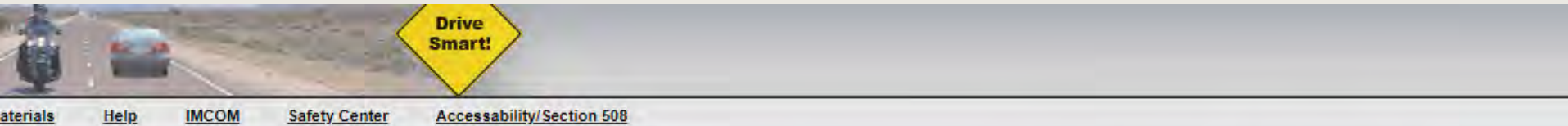

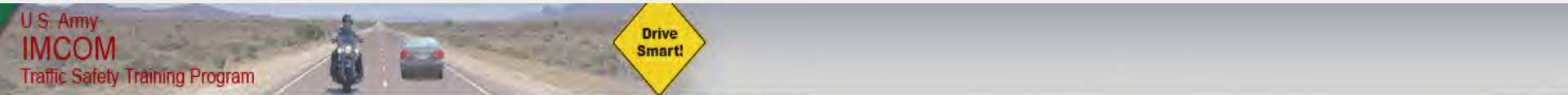






# Sign-Up Procedures

# IDT / RDT

## **PLEASE READ AND FOLLOW ALL INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Per AR 385-10, Intermediate Driver Training is a 2.5-hour course that is required for all Army personnel as part of the Army Traffic Safety Training Program. New Service Members on Fort Bliss under 26 years of age who have not had the training is required to take the training.**
- Remedial Driver Training is an 8-hour course addressing the root causes of aggressive driving.**
- IDT class is held every first Friday of the month.**
- RDT class is held every second Friday of the month.**
- No walk-in students allowed, must be registered through the AIRS system.**
- Bring a pen or pencil to write notes.**
- There is a quiz provided at the end of the course. Student must pass the quiz.**
