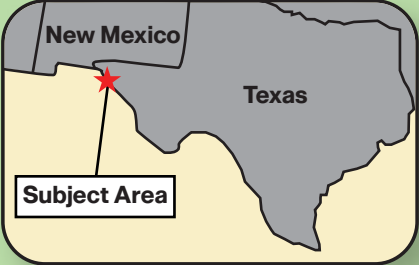
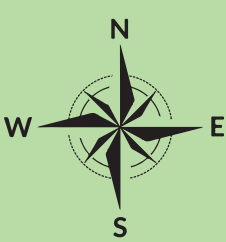


Texas National Defense Area (TXNDA)



The TXNDA spans over 60 miles along the Rio Grande River and the southern border, from El Paso to Fort Hancock.

The Army is working with federal agencies and local communities to ensure citizen safety, security, and territorial integrity along the border. The TXNDA includes only federal lands.
