POLICY MEMORANDUM #13

SUBJECT: Permanent Party (PP) Unaccompanied Housing (UH) for Geographically Separated Soldiers

1. References.

- a. AR 420-1, Army Facilities Management, Rapid Action Revision (RAR), 24 August 2012.
- b. AR 608-75, Exceptional Family Member Program, 27 January 2017.
- c. JTR, Chapter 10, Housing Allowances, Part E, Assignment Situations, Section E2, Member with Dependent, 1 July 2018.

2. Purpose. To outline the policy and process that determines eligibility for geographically separated married Soldiers to secure PP UH, Enlisted quarters.

3. Applicability. This policy applies to Soldiers in the rank of E1 thru E5.

4. Policy. Soldiers entitled to Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) at the with-dependent rate, who are assigned to Fort Bliss and voluntarily separated from their family members for personal reasons (that is, geographical bachelors), are not authorized assignment to PP UH. The Garrison Commander may grant an exception to policy (ETP) on a case-by-case basis when certain extenuating circumstances warrant approval. Exceptions will be determined using enclosed criteria and receipt of documentation and will be approved on a space available basis for service members in the rank of E1-E5.

5. Minimum standards of adequacy do not apply to residents in this category. Prior to assignment, these individuals will be advised in writing they may be required to vacate barracks for personnel in priorities I and II upon 30-day notice. Priorities of assignment will be made per AR 420-1, Table 3-5, note 3 applies.
