## MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Command Policy Letter #19, Off-Post Living Authorization for Non-Authorized Personnel

- 1. References. Army Regulation (AR) 420-1, Army Facilities Management (12 February 2008, Rapid Action Revision 24 August 2012); Army Barracks Management Program Handbook (12 January 2021); and AR 600-20, Army Command Policy (24 July 2020).
- 2. Purpose. This policy establishes the Commanding General's withholding authority for non-authorized personnel that request to live off-post. Non-authorized personnel includes Service Members (SM) assigned to the barracks who do not meet the criteria to receive an approved Exception to Policy (ETP) in accordance with AR 420-1 regardless of Basic Allowance for Housing status.
- 3. Applicability. This policy applies to all Uniformed SMs assigned or attached to or otherwise performing duties at Fort Bliss, Texas, regardless of branch of military service or component when on active duty, inactive duty training, or in a duty status under Title 10 of the U.S. Code.
- 4. Policy. The approval and denial authority for SMs requesting an ETP to live off-post for a reason other than those listed in AR 420-1, para. 3-20(k)(2), is hereby withheld to the Commanding General, 1st Armored Division and Fort Bliss. The Garrison Commander retains the approval and denial authority for requests made pursuant to AR 420-1, para. 3-20(k)(2).
