SURVIVOR ASSISTANCE

When a Retired Soldier dies the Next of Kin (NoK) should immediately contact this office so that we can brief the NoK of all benefits they may be entitled to and the many agencies that need to be notified in order to make those benefits happen. Of particular importance is the Defense Finance and Accounting Service - Cleveland (DFAS-CL). This stops the Retired Pay of the deceased Retired Soldier. If it is not stopped, this could result in family members being indebted to the government, causing delays in getting other benefits started – such as the Arrears of Pay and Survivor Benefit Plan. We have developed a Survivor Assistance Guide to inform Retired Soldiers and their Families about the process in preparing well ahead of time for a Retired Soldier's passing.
