The North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation (SBI) is seeking a highly qualified information technology professional who will be primarily responsible for the installation, configuration, operation, monitoring, maintenance, programming, and technical support of North Carolina's Law Enforcement Message Switch (LEMS), which is the hub for accessing law enforcement information throughout NC. It is a full-time position (40 hours per week) with state benefits including retirement, health insurance, vacation leave, sick leave, and paid holidays. **This position is oncall 24x7 for two out of every four weeks.**

Serving as the technical lead, the scope of this work encompasses varied information exchange methodologies between the Unisys LEMS/JX product upon which LEMS is built and all of the following: client devices, Metro systems (such as county and city dispatch, records management, and 911 systems), SBI database systems, other NC criminal justice agency database systems, NC DMV systems, FBI's National Crime Information Center (NCIC), and The International Justice and Public Safety Network (Nlets). This individual will also be responsible for installation, configuration, and administration of IBM WebSphere MQ servers and Microsoft BizTalk servers and applications interfacing with LEMS.

Typical work activities include the following:

 Perform routine operational tasks, monitoring and responding to support requests and system alerts, and problem determination and resolution for SBI's Law Enforcement Message Switch (LEMS), IBM WebSphere MQ implementations, Microsoft BizTalk, and FTP servers on 24x7x365 basis, including coordination with IT owners of interfacing systems in

- local, state, and federal agencies.
- Install Unisys LEMS/JX, its components, and IBM WebSphere MQ. Keep informed of product roadmaps for LEMS/JX, BizTalk, and WebSphere MQ as well as updates/patches, and provide this information to management and other SBI IT staff working with these products. Analyze the impact of server patches and upgrades in LEMS/JX, BizTalk, and WebSphere MQ and supporting operating system and database software and plan and implement such patches and upgrades.
- Communicate and coordinate effectively with users, other SBI IT stakeholders, IT stakeholders from other local, state, and federal agencies, and technology vendors for new and existing LEMS interfaces to assess needs, define interface functionality, and complete implementations. Define technical solutions for LEMS interfaces, including component definitions, task definitions, estimates of effort, skills required, and hardware/software requirements and make associated recommendations to supervisor. Plan, guide, monitor, and ensure the quality of the work of other developers assigned to work on LEMS.
- Perform analysis, design, configuration, programming, testing, and implementation in the creation, enhancement, and maintenance of interfaces between SBI's LEMS and other SBI, state agency, federal, and international criminal justice and public safety systems.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES / COMPETENCIES:

Applicant must be a US Citizen due to security requirements for SBI systems to which the person in this position must have access.

Selected candidates will undergo and must successfully complete a comprehensive background investigation which includes: pre-employment polygraph examination; credit and arrest checks; interviews with associates, personal and business references; verification interviews of employers; verification of education achievement; urinalysis drug screening; and submission of fingerprints.

Bachelor's degree in computer science, computer engineering, or a closely related field from an appropriately accredited institution and four years of progressive experience in systems software programming; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
